





#### By Residency\* and Student Level







#### **Highlights**

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Spring Term courses were offered by remote access.
- Main Campus headcount enrollment grew by 2.0% compared to last Spring, although FTE declined by 0.7% despite a jump in Ecampus FTE, which was unable to offset losses elsewhere.
- OSU Cascades also saw a 13.1% increase in headcount as well as a 6.2 increase in FTE. This was largely driven by non-degree graduate enrollment, which is up 54.3% compared with last year.
- College of Engineering continues to be the largest college nearly 30% of headcount
