



## Degrees Conferred by Academic Unit and Degree Type: 2003-04




# Number of Students Graduated: 2003–04



By Academic Unit and Gender





## Grade Point Average, Graduating Class of 2004





## Highlights

- The number of degrees awarded during the 2003–04 academic year was 4,114. This was the largest number of degrees ever awarded by OSU in any given academic year. OSU has awarded 178,828 degrees through 135 annual commencements.
- Compared to 2002–03, the total number of degrees awarded increased by 5.7%. The number of Bachelor degrees increased by 4.7%; First Professional degrees increased by 15.7%; Master's degrees increased by 9.7%; and Doctoral degrees decreased by 1.8%.
- Eight students received three degrees, and 101 students received two degrees.
- The College of Engineering awarded the largest number of degrees (754) when compared to the other academic units.
- The average age for Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degree recipients was 25, 30, 35, 29, and 37, respectively.
- Women were awarded 71% of the first professional degrees.
- The College of Health and Human Sciences had the largest percentage of U.S. Minority graduates: 18.5%.
- The number of U.S. minority graduates was 482. Of all the graduates in 2003–04, 12.1% were U.S. minorities. OSU saw more U.S. minority women than men earn degrees in academic year 2003–04.
- Seventy-seven percent of the graduates were Oregon residents; 14% of the graduates were from other U.S. states; and 8% of the graduates were international students.

- The grade point average (GPA) for students receiving Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degrees was 3.15, 3.73, 3.79, 3.15, and 3.77, respectively.
- The new B.A., B.S. concurrent degree program in Education (four students) and the M.S. in Applied Physics (one student) awarded degrees for the first time.
