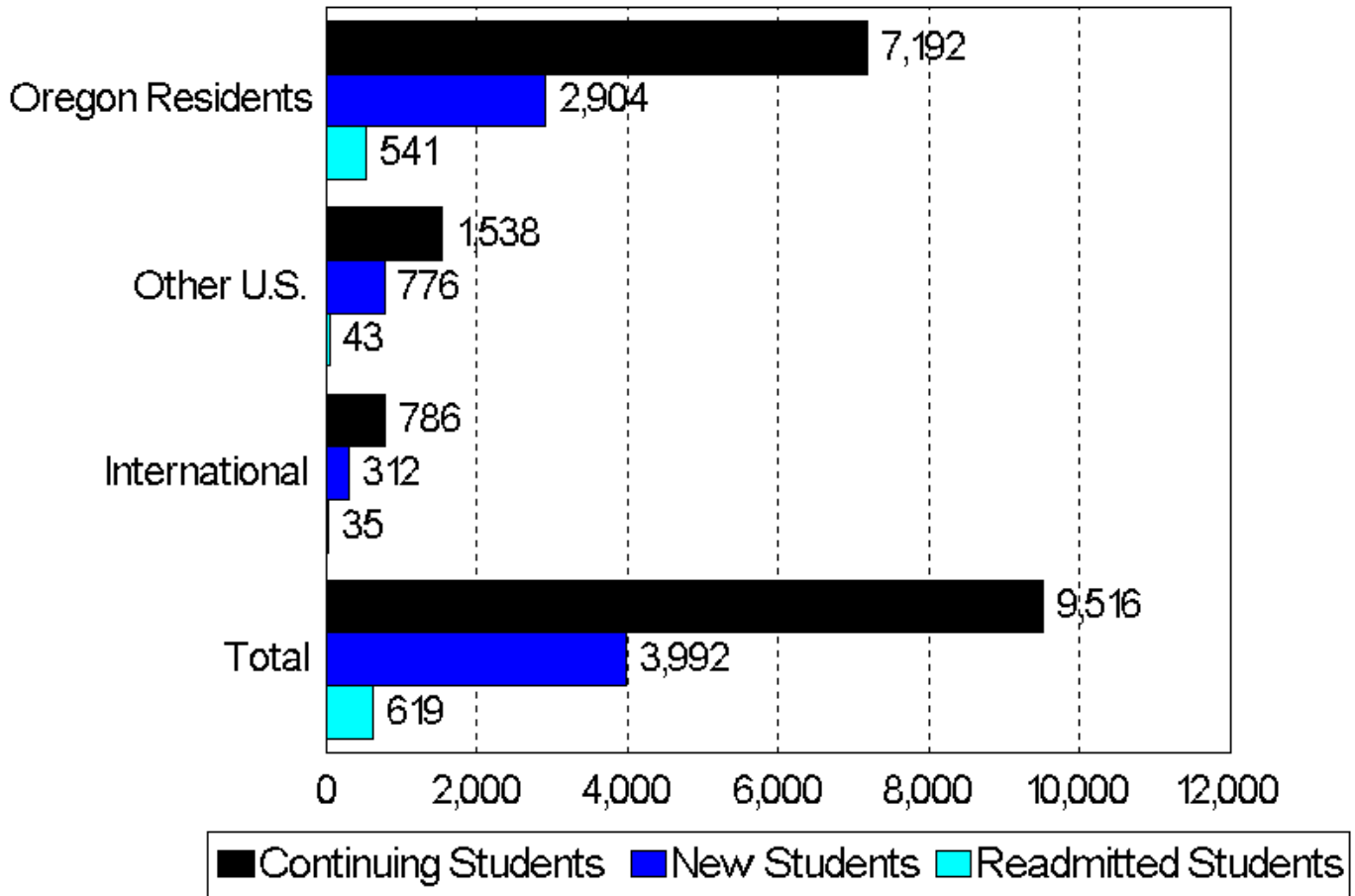

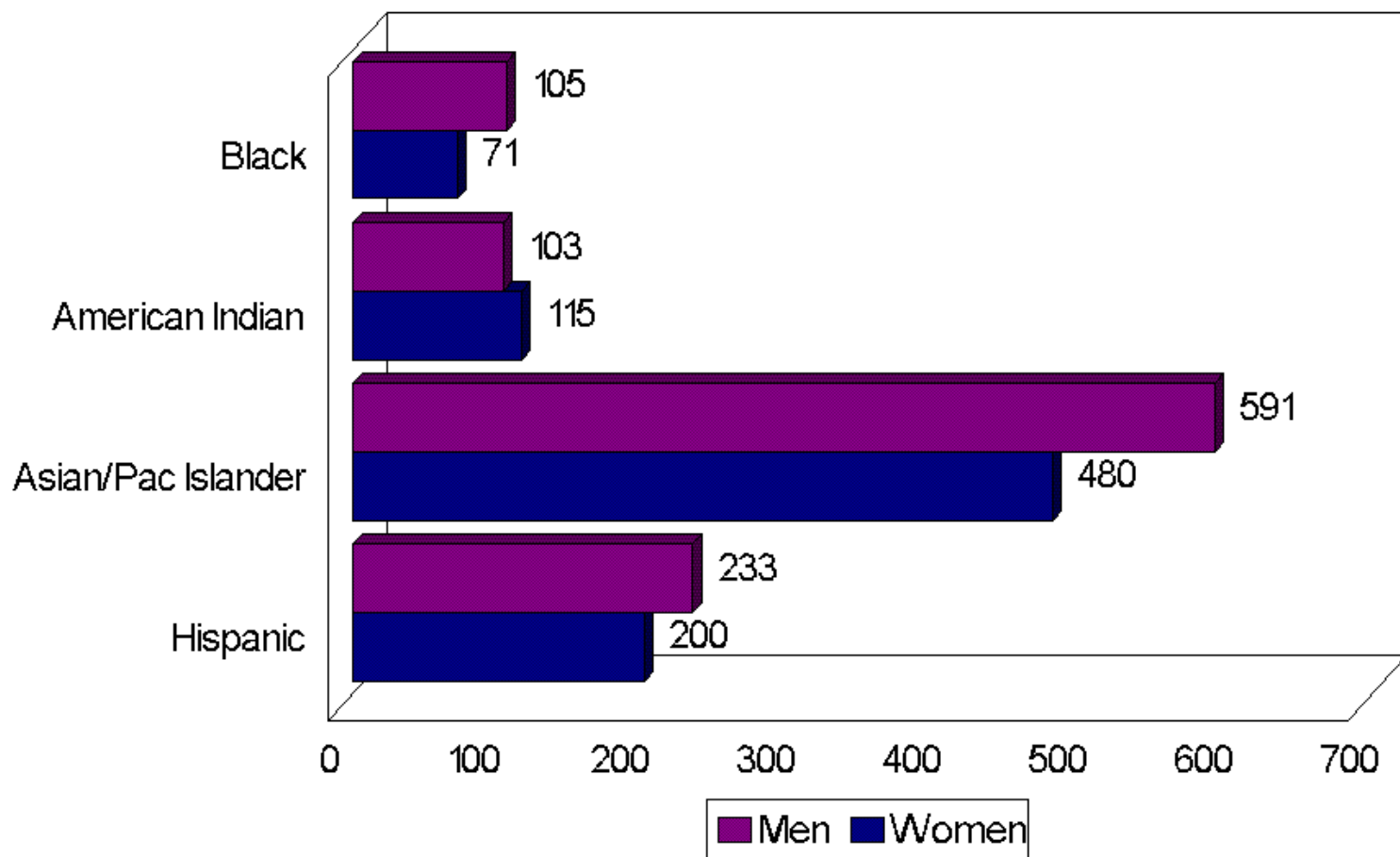
# Residency By Level



# New Students By Residency



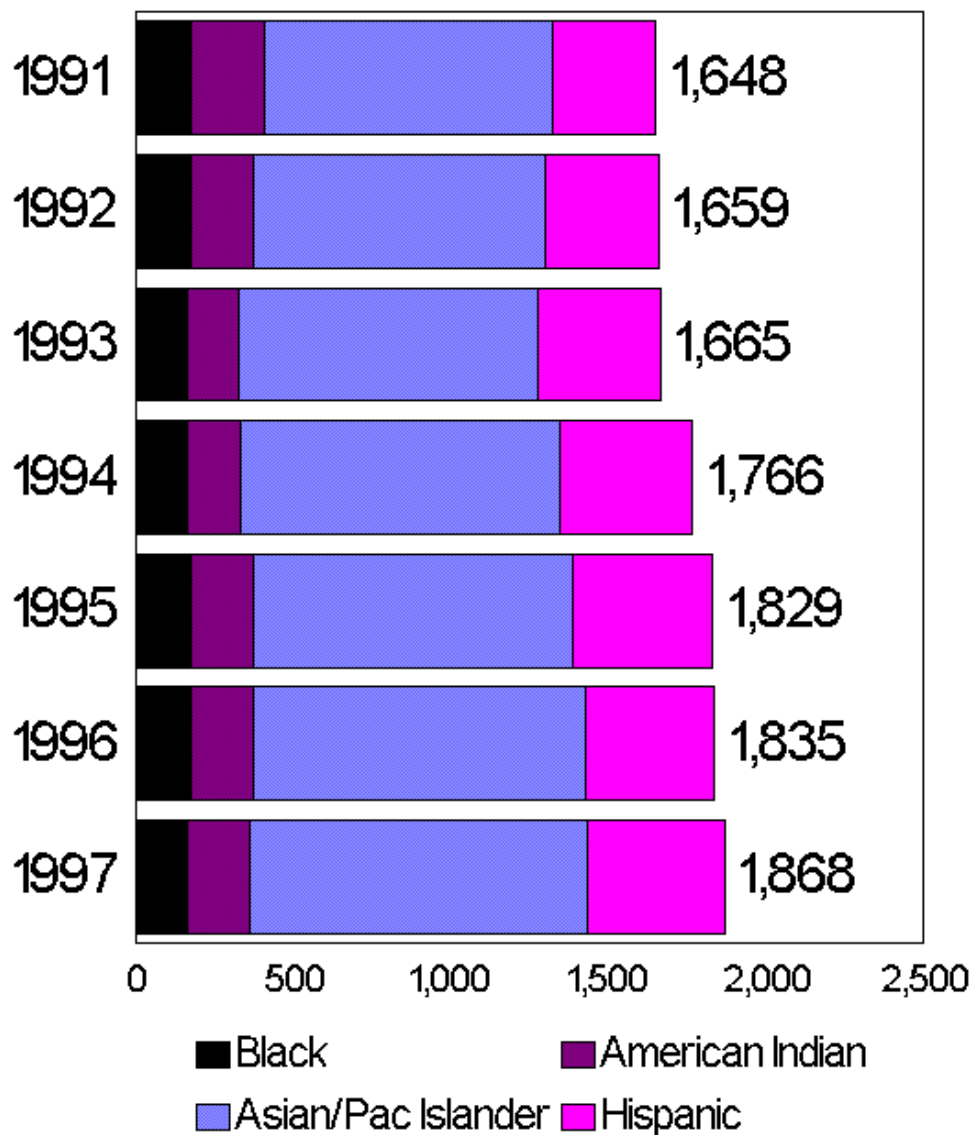
# U. S. Minorities By Gender



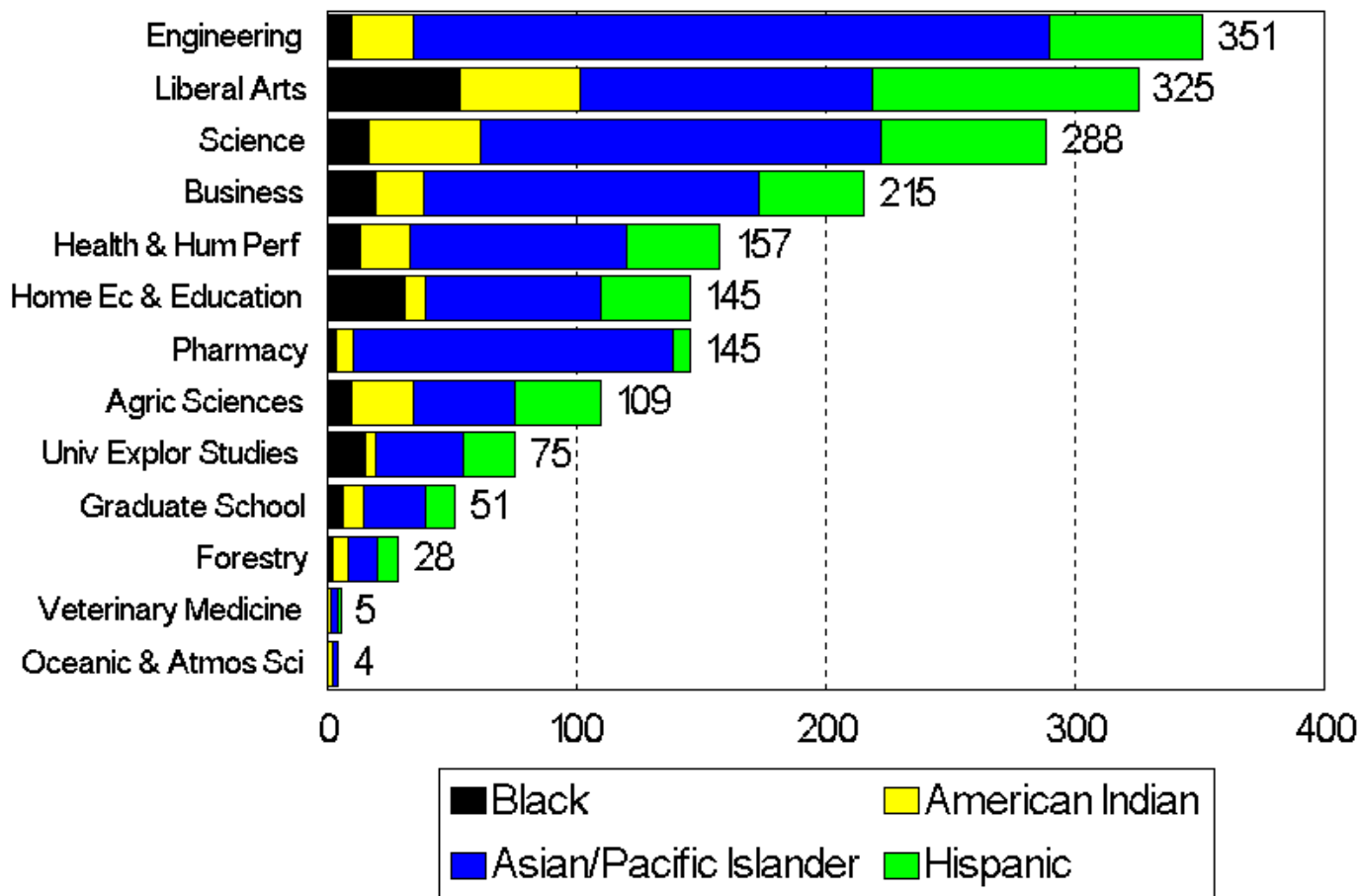

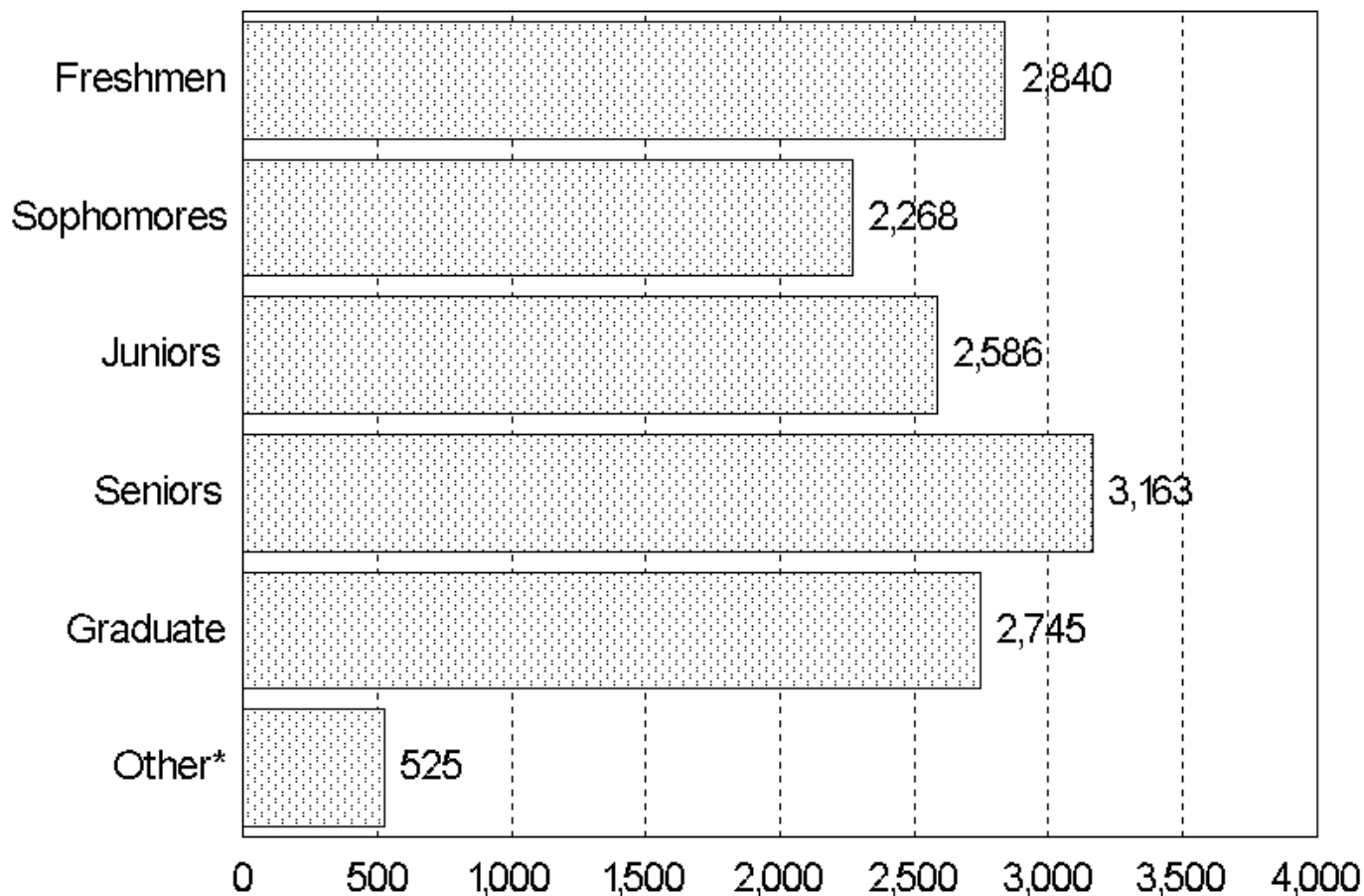
## Seven-Year Comparison

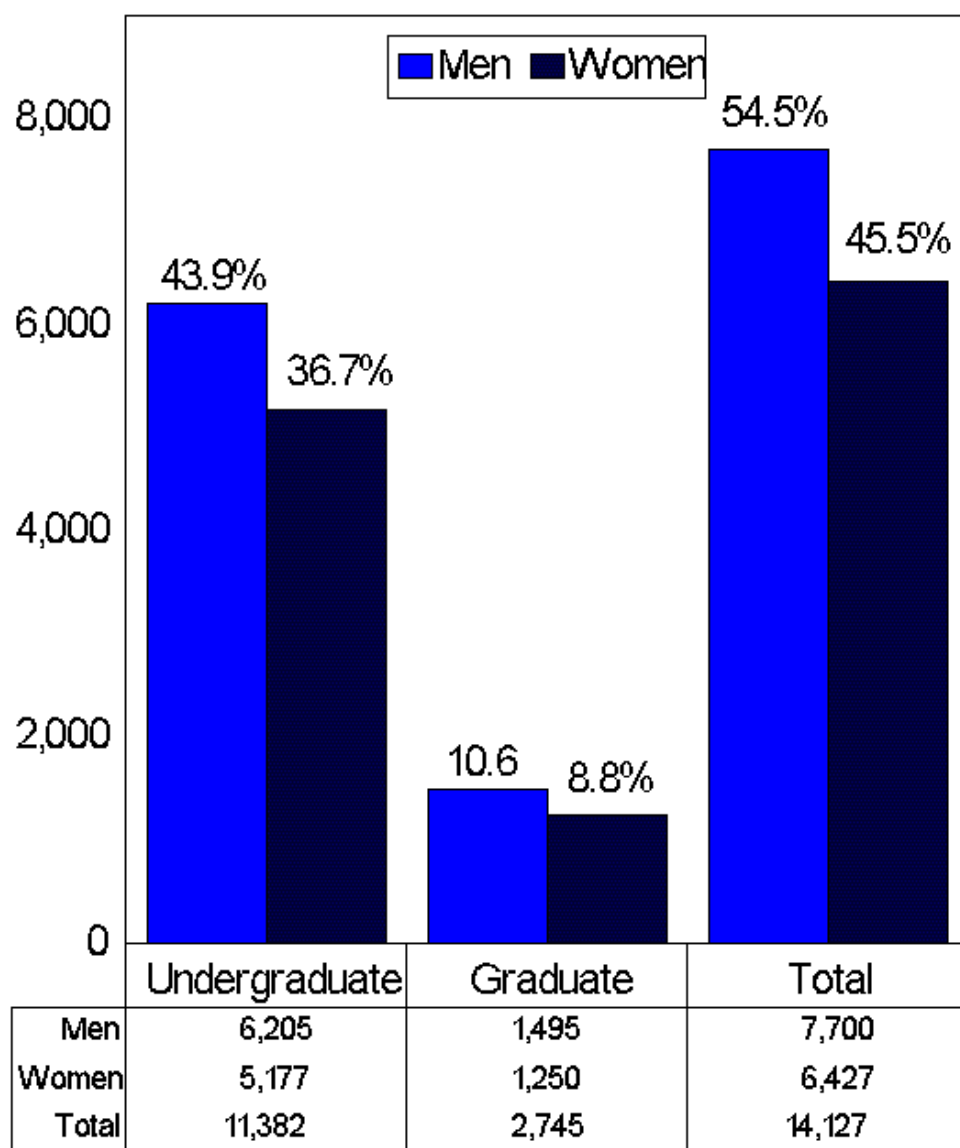


# Headcount Enrollment By Class



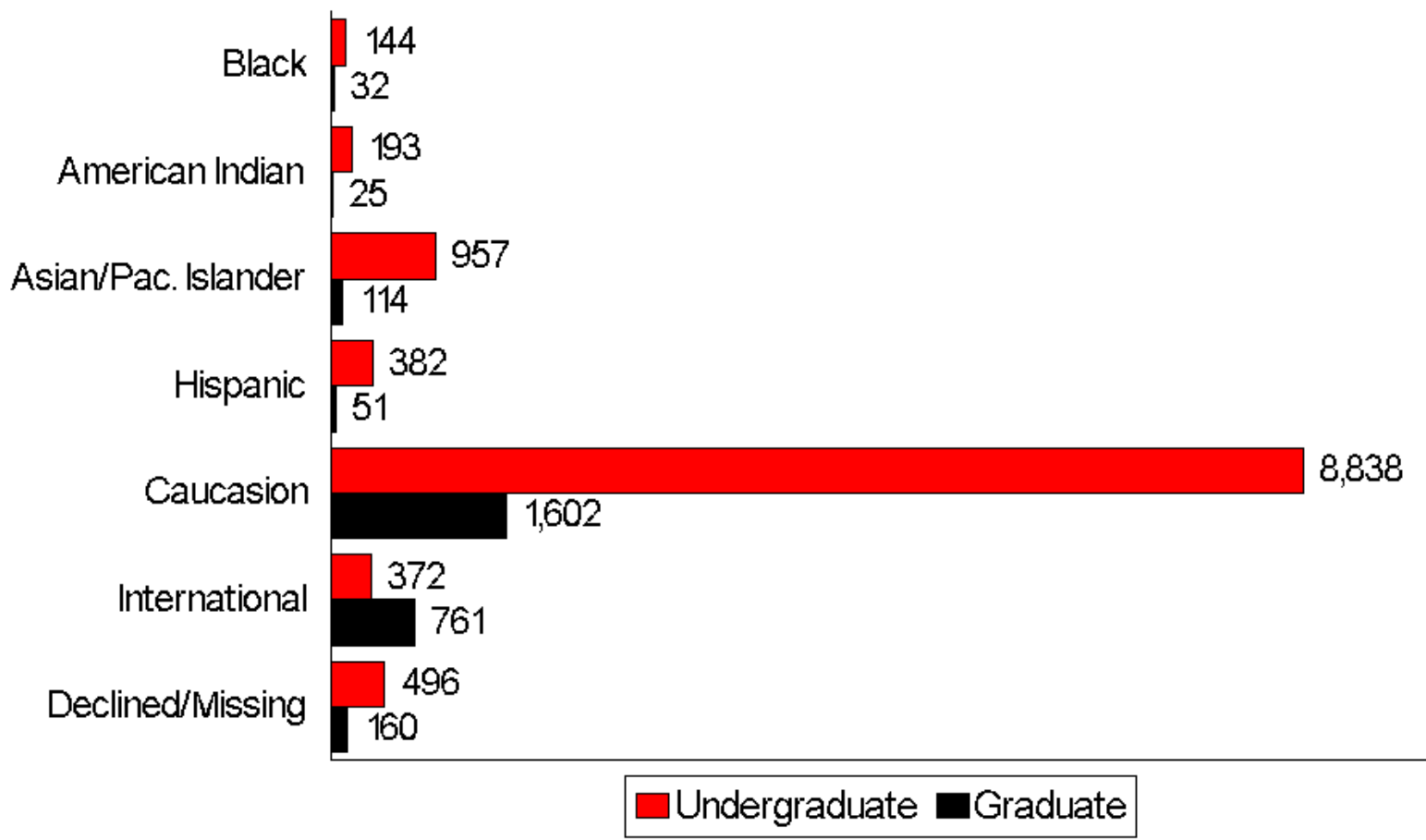

# Enrollment By Gender & By Level



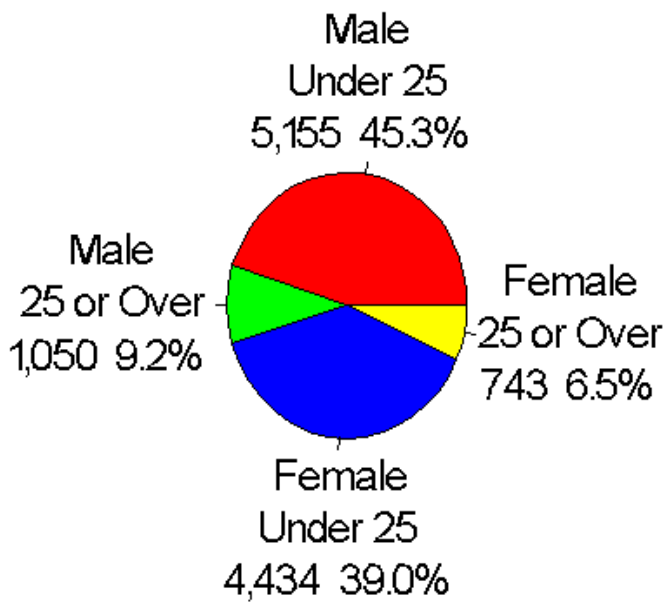


# Ethnicity - All Students By Level
