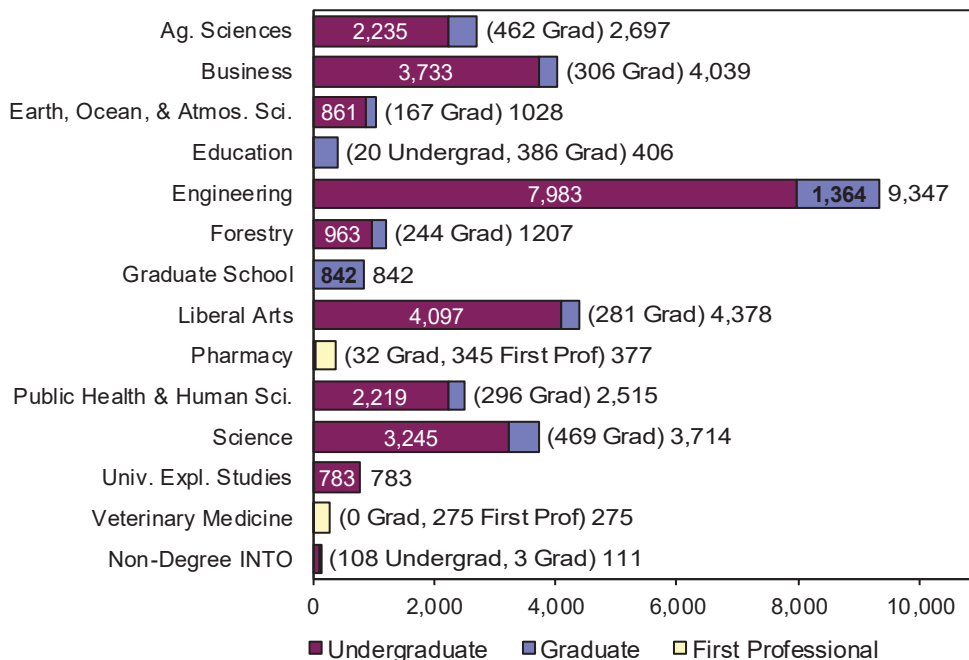

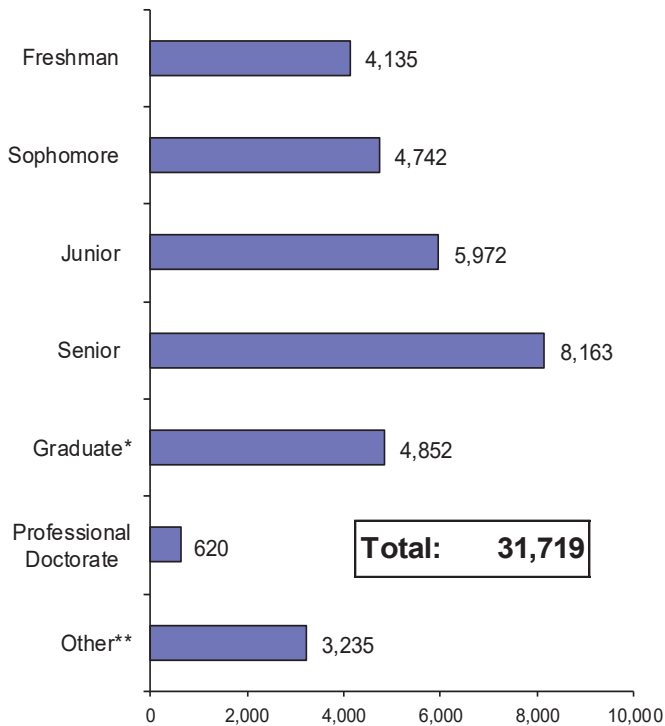

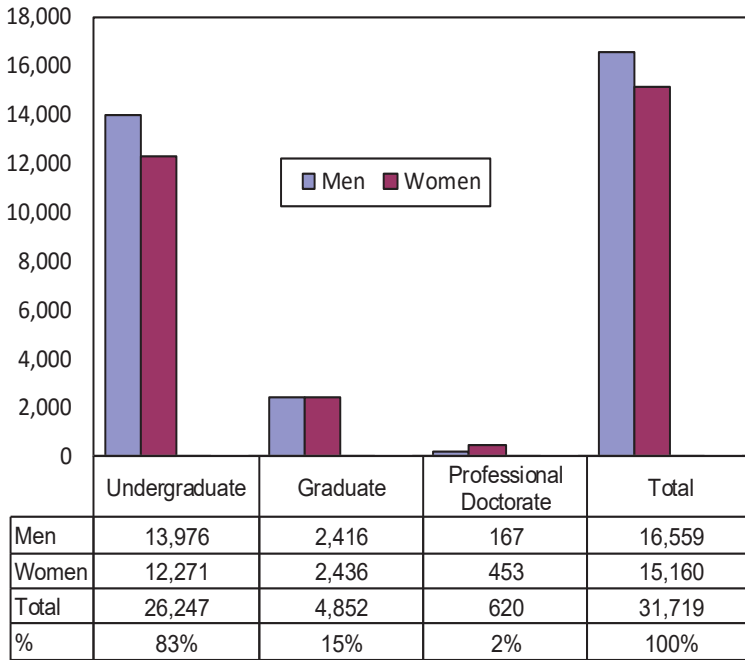

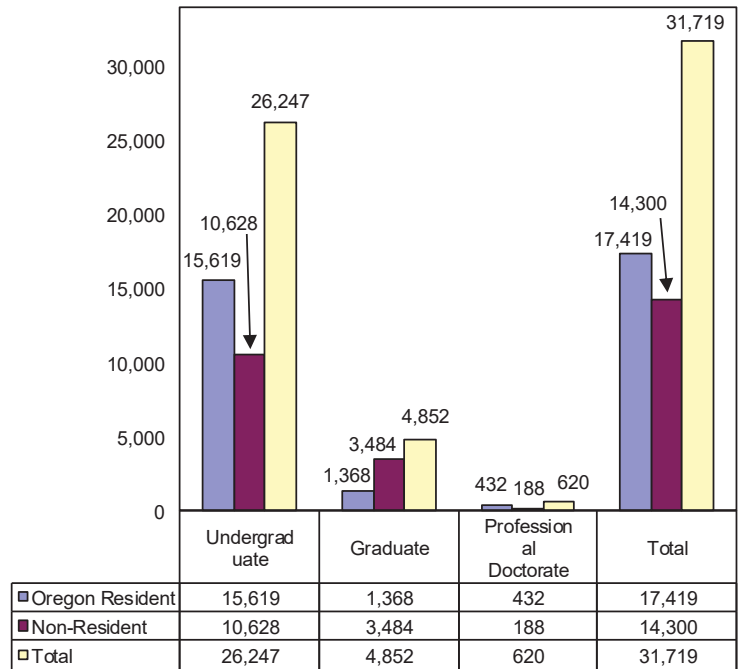

Enrollment by Sex—Binary and Student Level

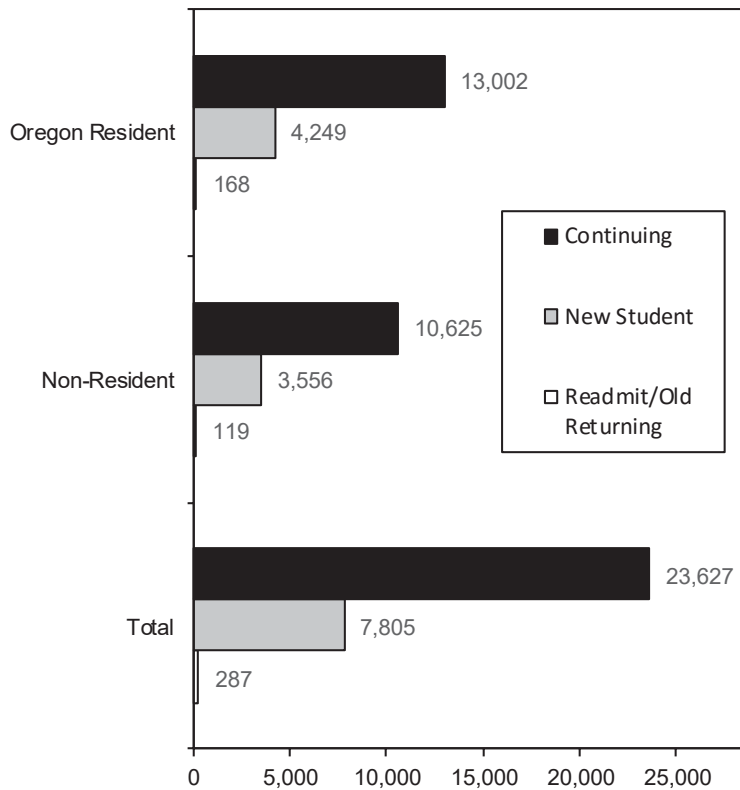


By Residency* and Student Level



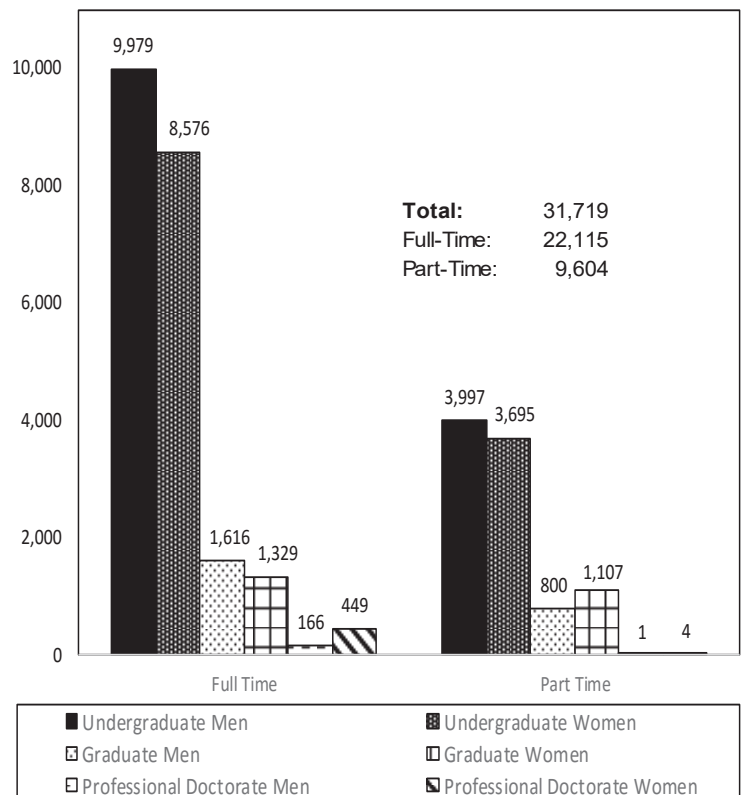

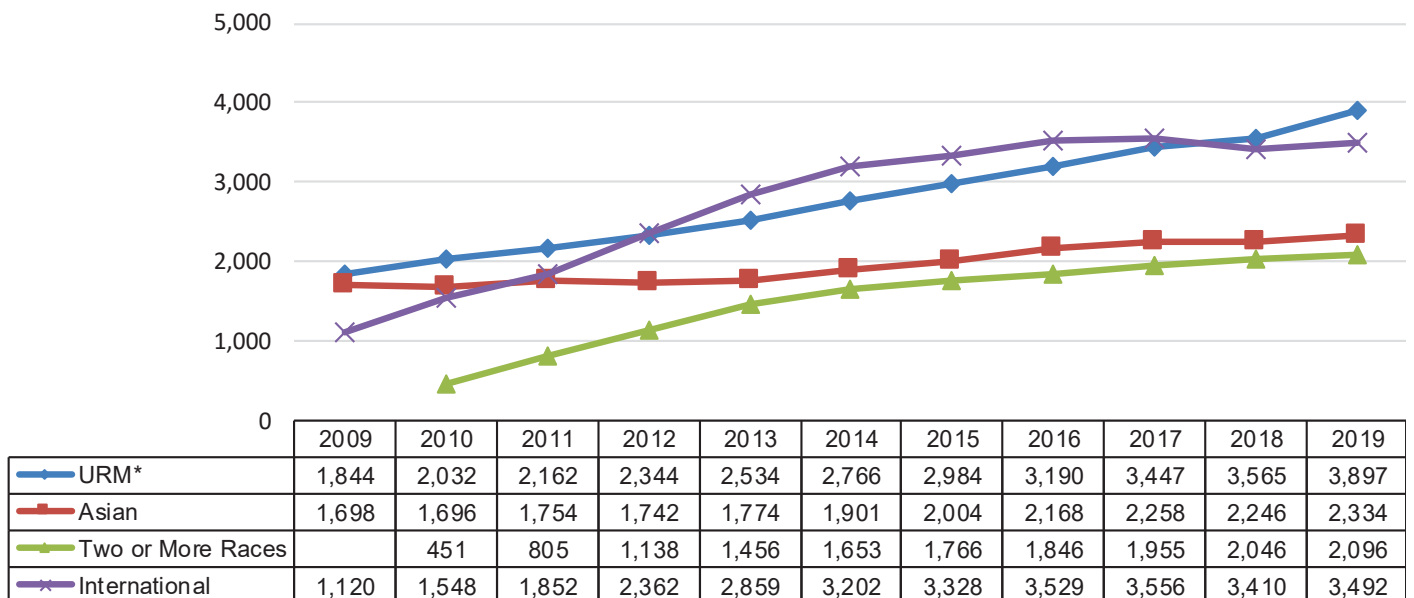

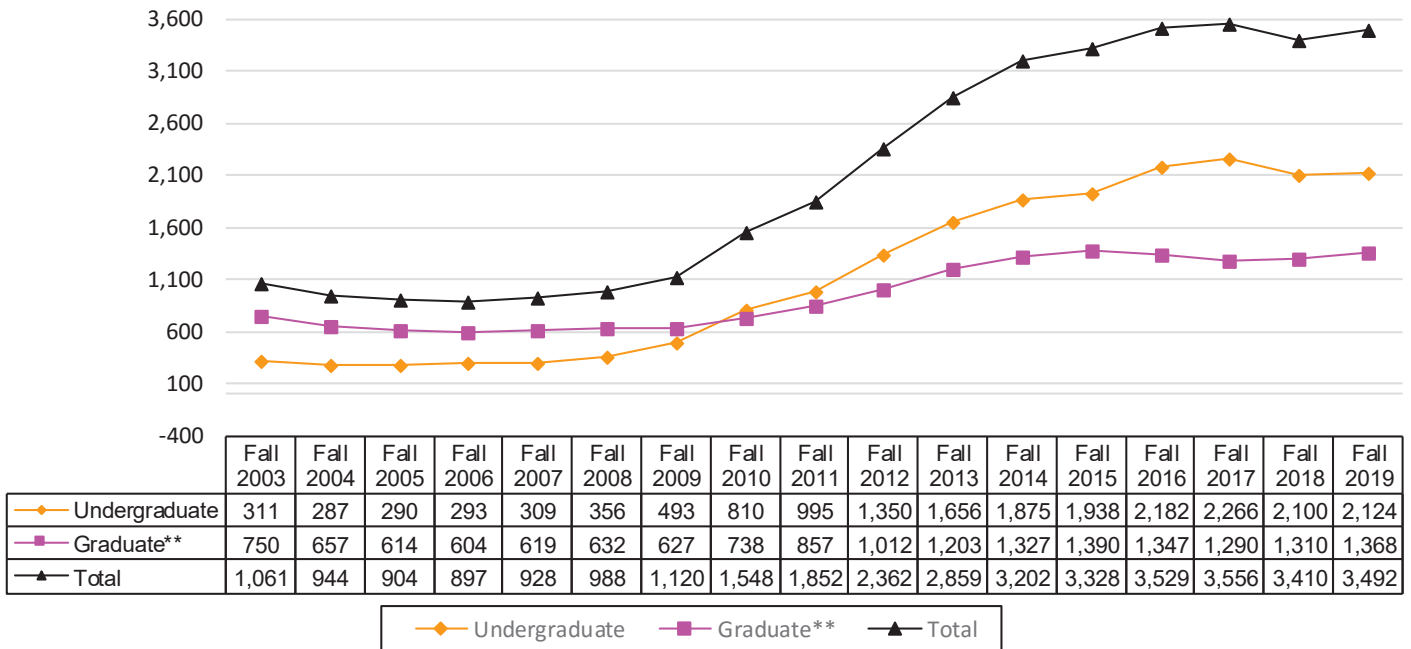

Enrollment by Geographic Origin

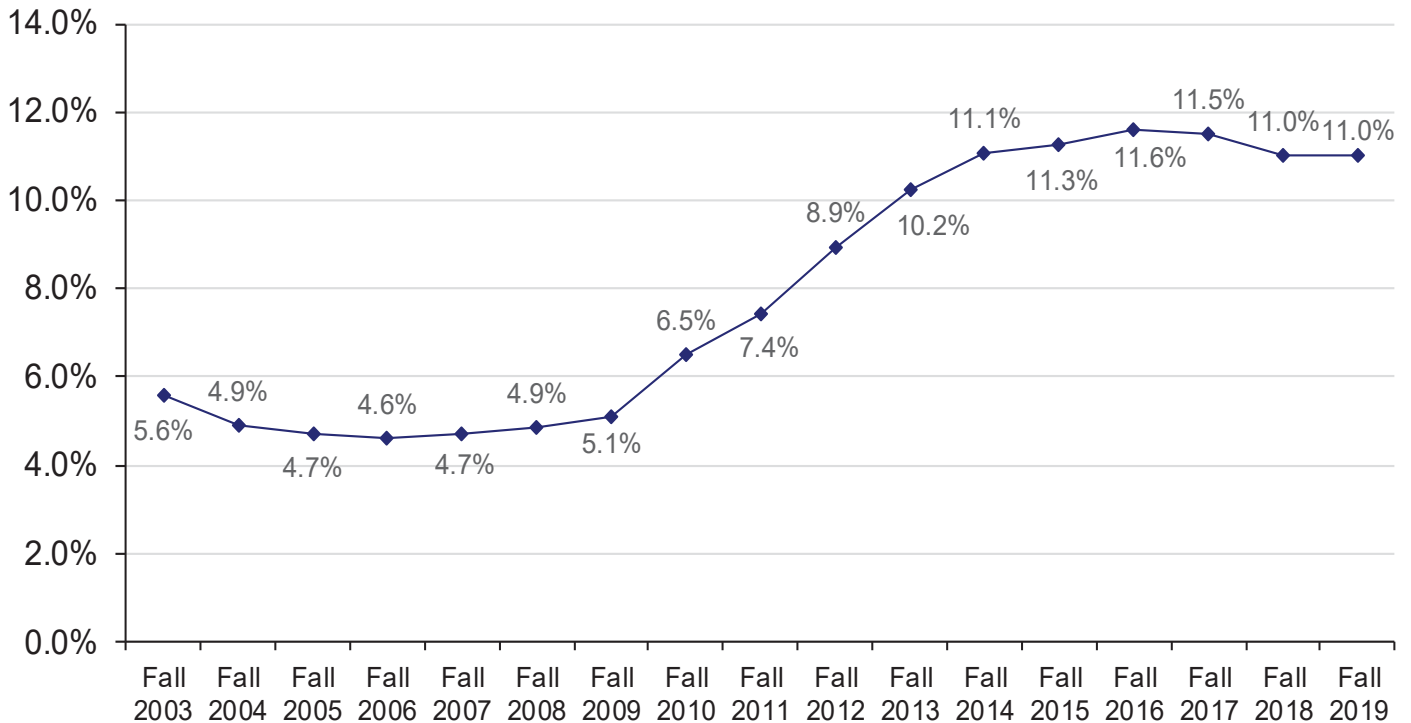

International Student Percent of Total OSU Enrollment



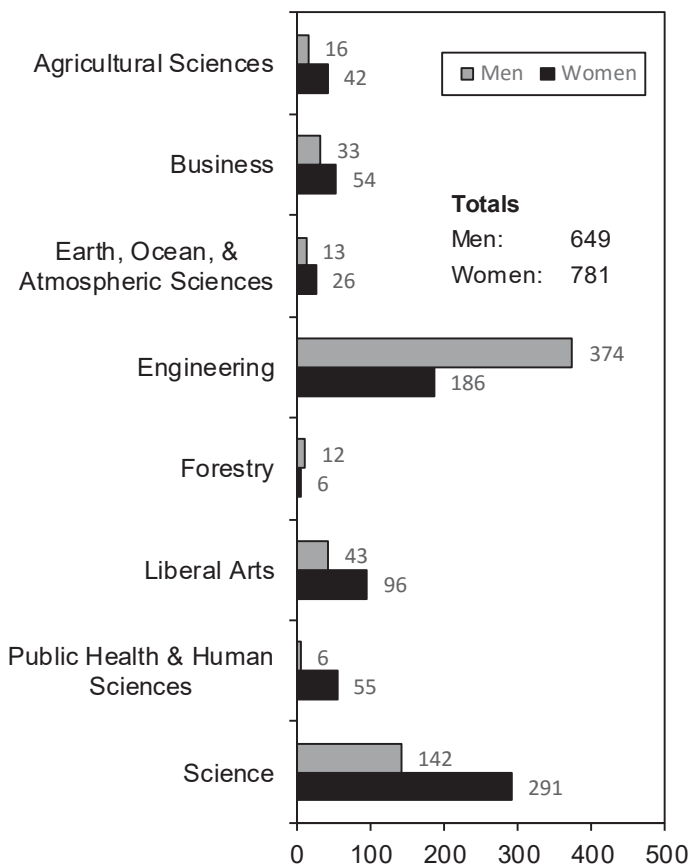

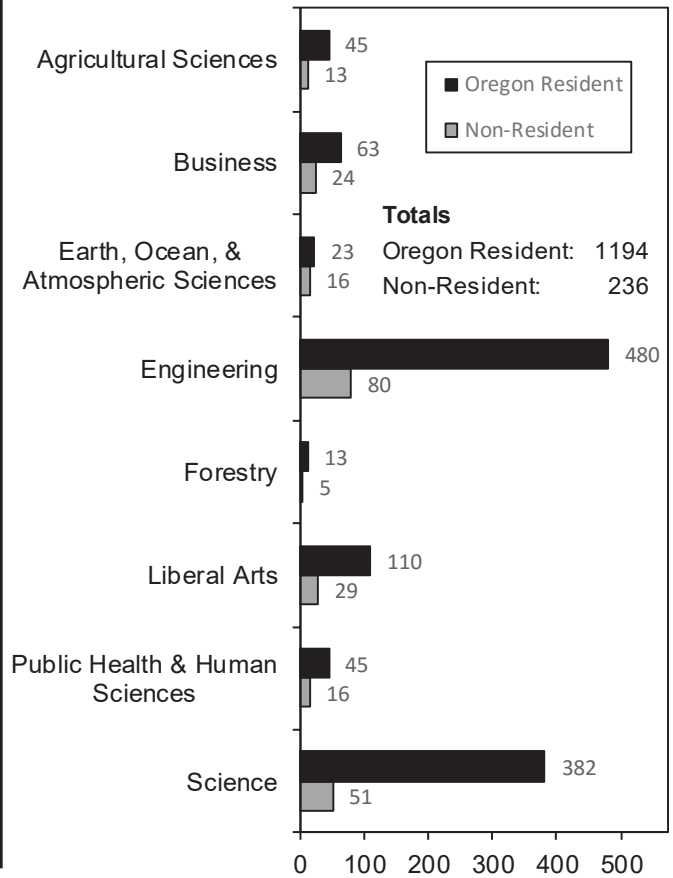

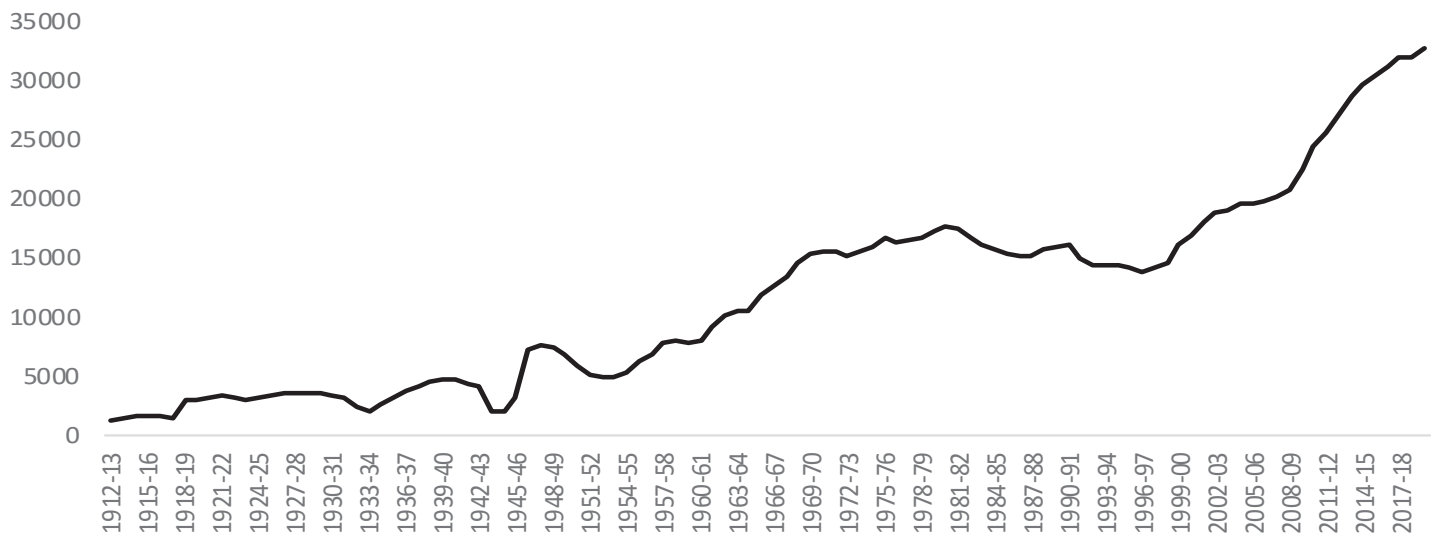
