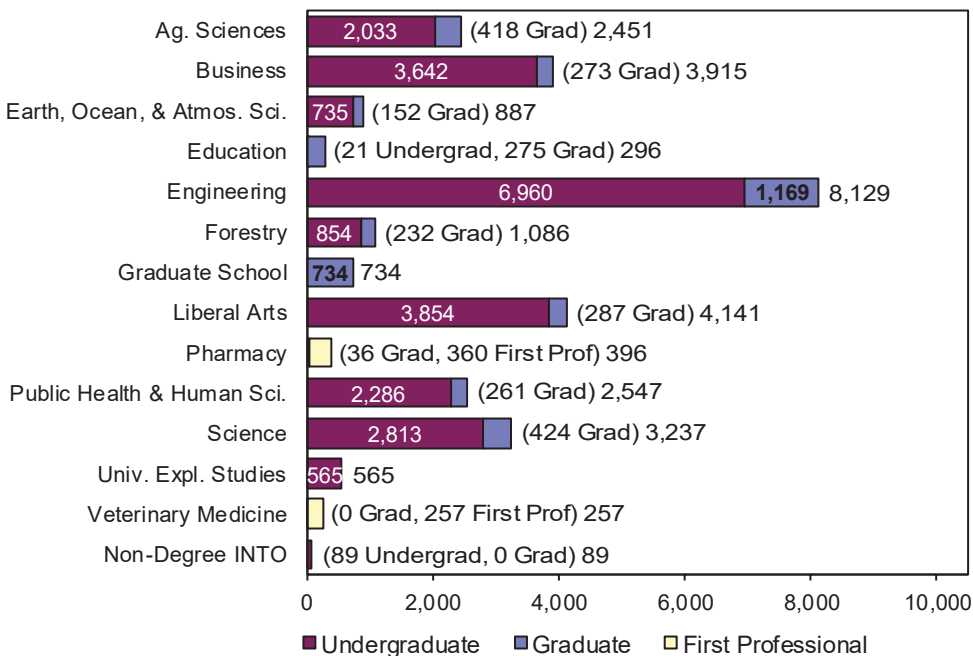

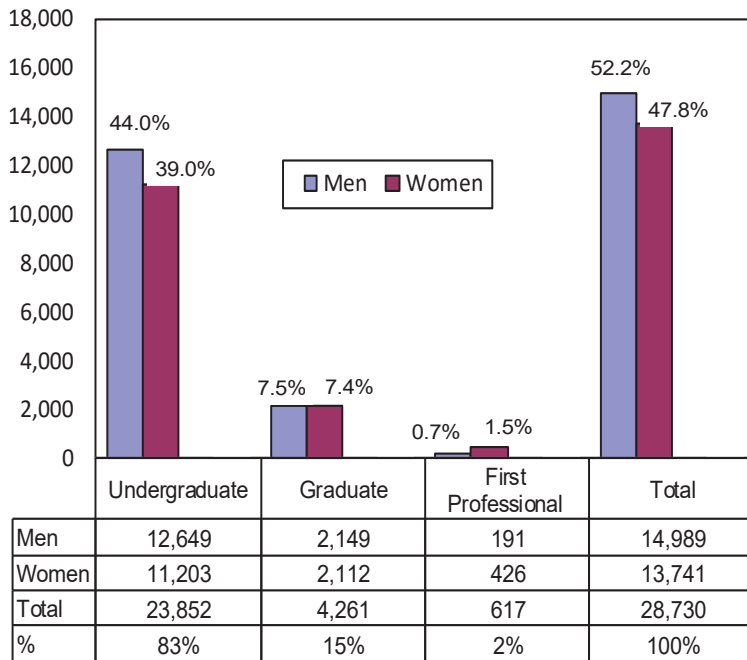

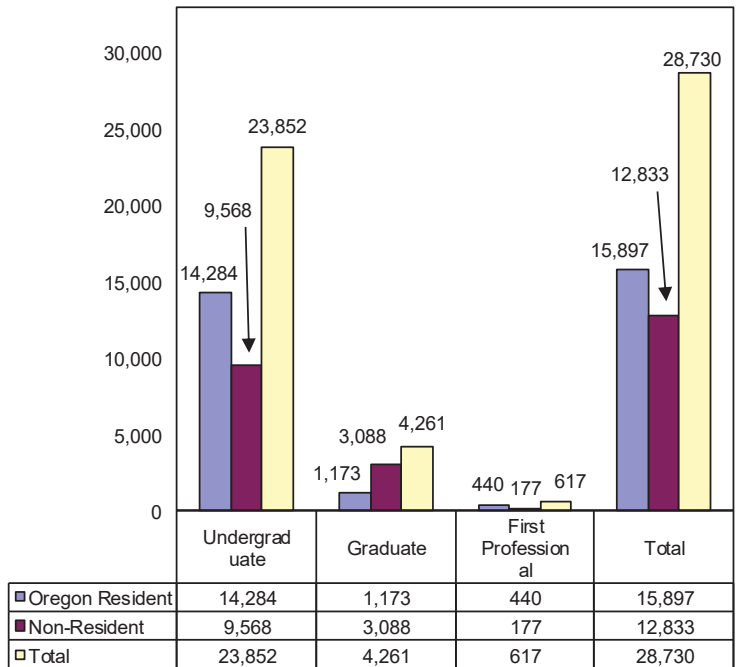

By Residency* and Student Level

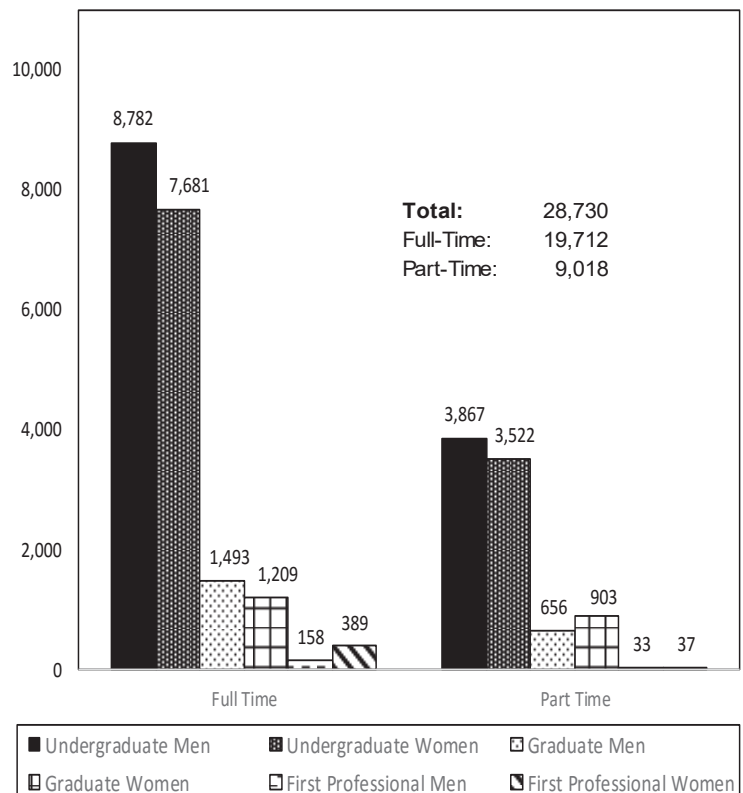

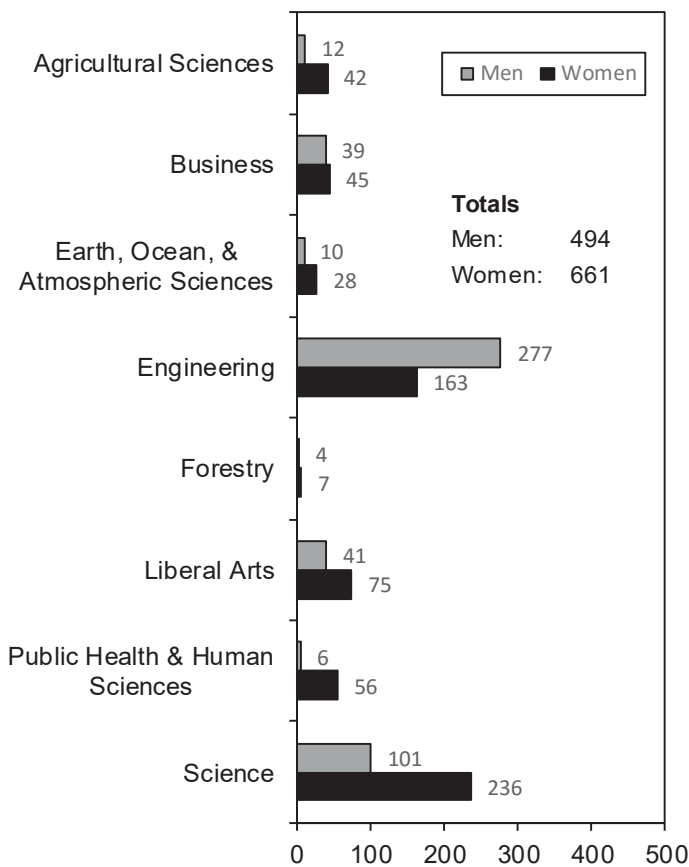

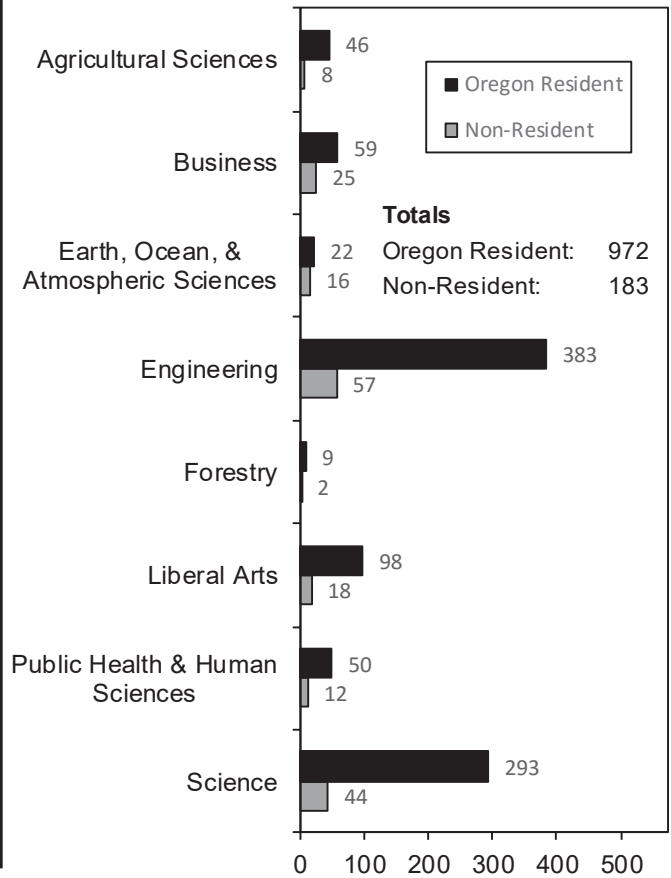

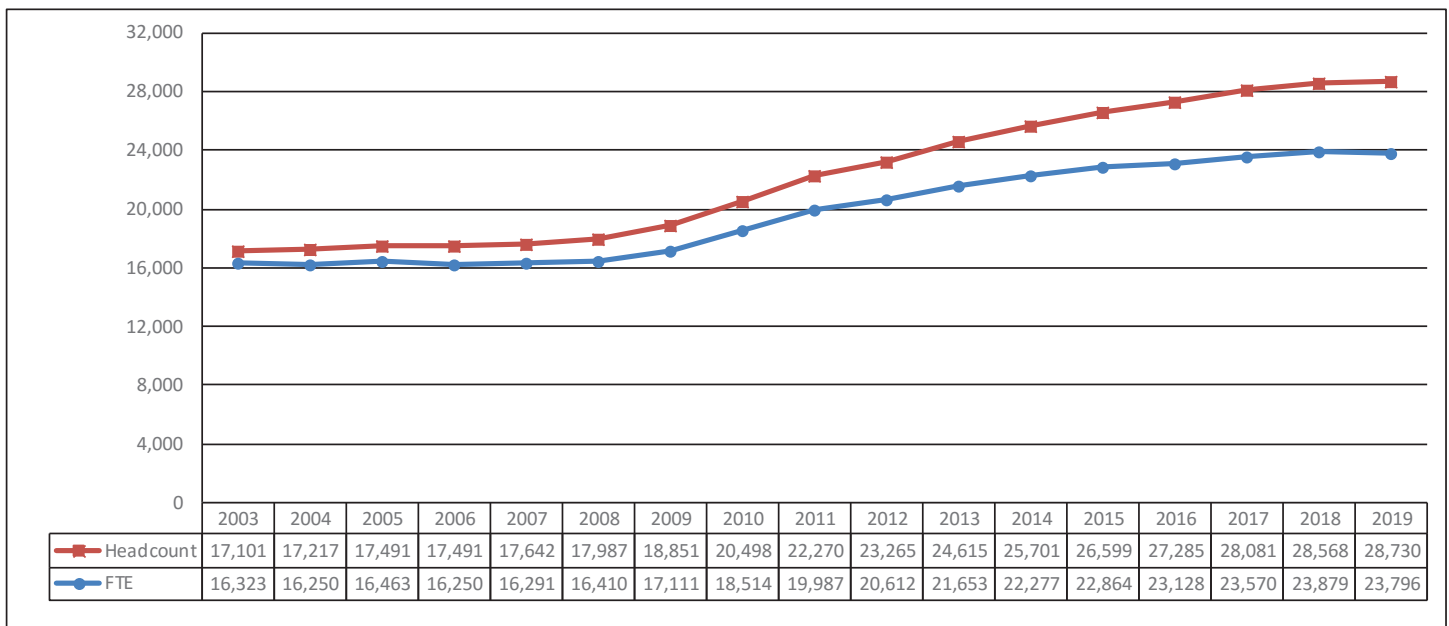

Highlights

- When Spring 2018 and Spring 2019 are compared, the total enrollment increased by 162 students, or 0.6% (from 28,568 to 28,730). At the same time, the total student FTE decreased by 82.7, or 0.3% (from 23,879.1 to 23,796.4), and the student credit hours decreased by 1,318, or 0.4% (from 338,222 to 336,904).
- When compared to Spring 2018, the undergraduate enrollment increased by 3 students, or 0.0% (from 23,852); the graduate enrollment increased by 3.2% (from 4,127 to 4,261); the first professional enrollment increased by 2.1% (from 592 to 617).
- When compared to Spring 2018, Oregon residents decreased by 1.9%; non-residents increased by 3.7%.
- International student enrollment decreased by 2.6%.
- For Spring 2019, the percentage of U.S. minority students was 25.7% of the total enrollment. The number of minority students increased by 4.4% when compared to Spring 2018 (from 7,073 to 7,384).
- The College of Engineering, College of Liberal Arts, and College of Business had the largest student enrollments (8,129, 4,141, and 3,915 respectively) when compared to the other academic units.
- OSU Extended Campus had 15,097 students, an increase of 6.7% compared to Spring 2018. These students took 85,410 credits, of which 28.8% were from the College of Liberal Arts, while 16.3% were from the College of Agriculture.
- During Spring 2019, a total of 1,203 students received services from OSU Cascades Campus.
- Other increases that occurred when comparing Spring 2018 and Spring 2019 are as follows:
 - Part-time students: 5.1%
 - Female students: 2.1%
- Other decreases that occurred when comparing Spring 2018 and Spring 2019 are as follows:
