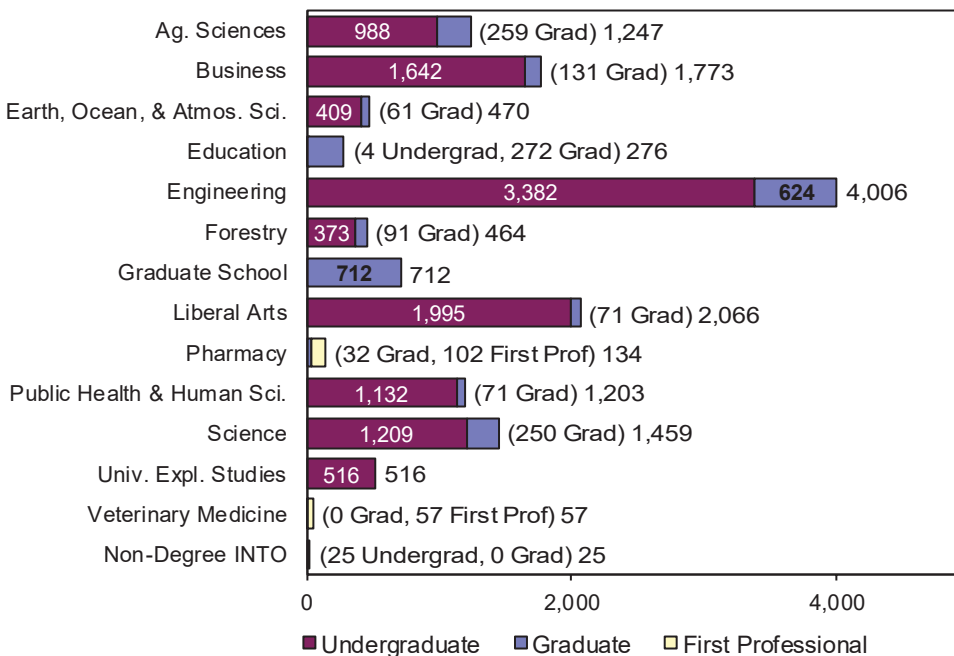

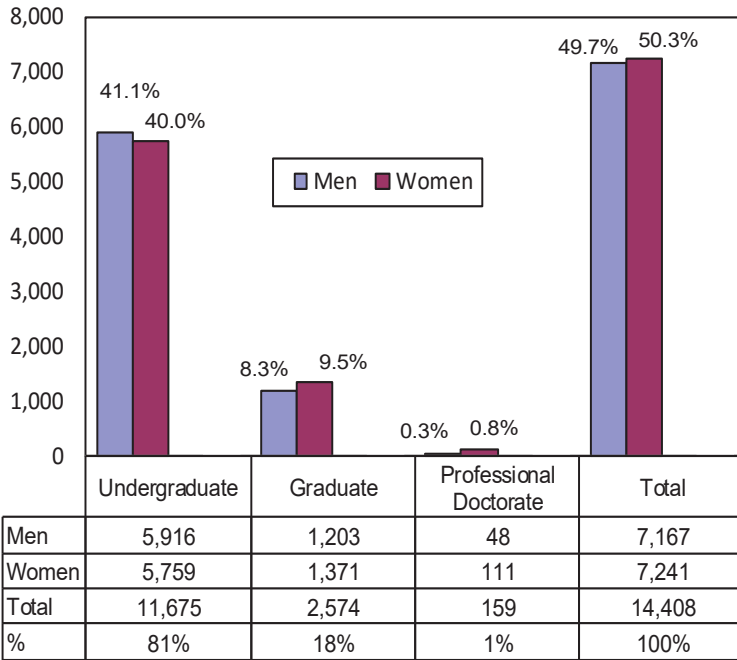

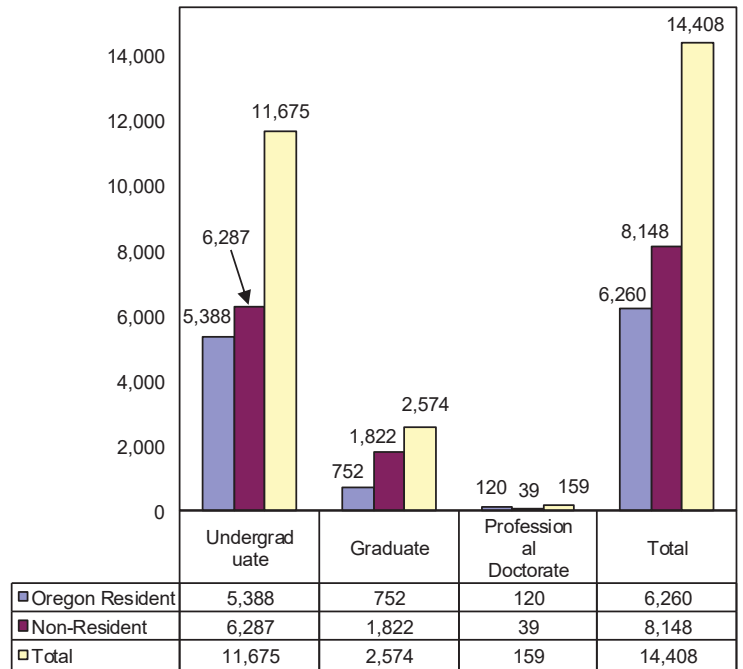

## Enrollment by Sex—Binary and Student Level

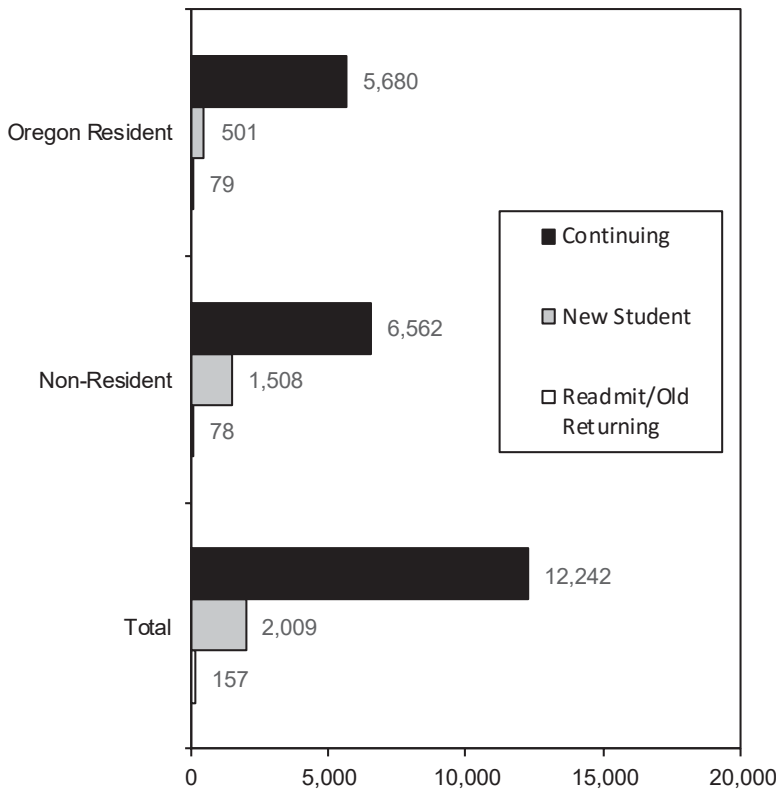


## By Residency\* and Student Level



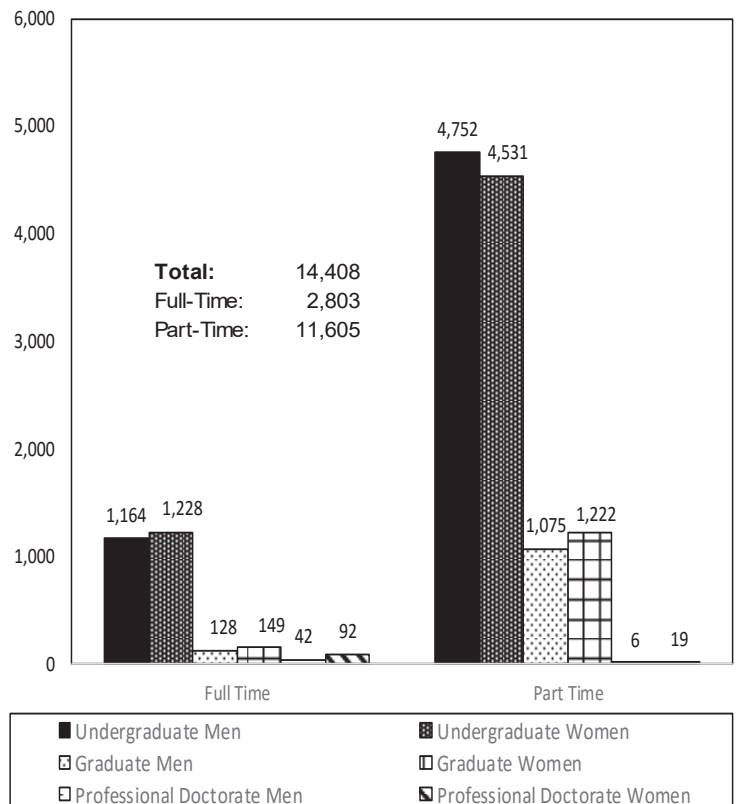

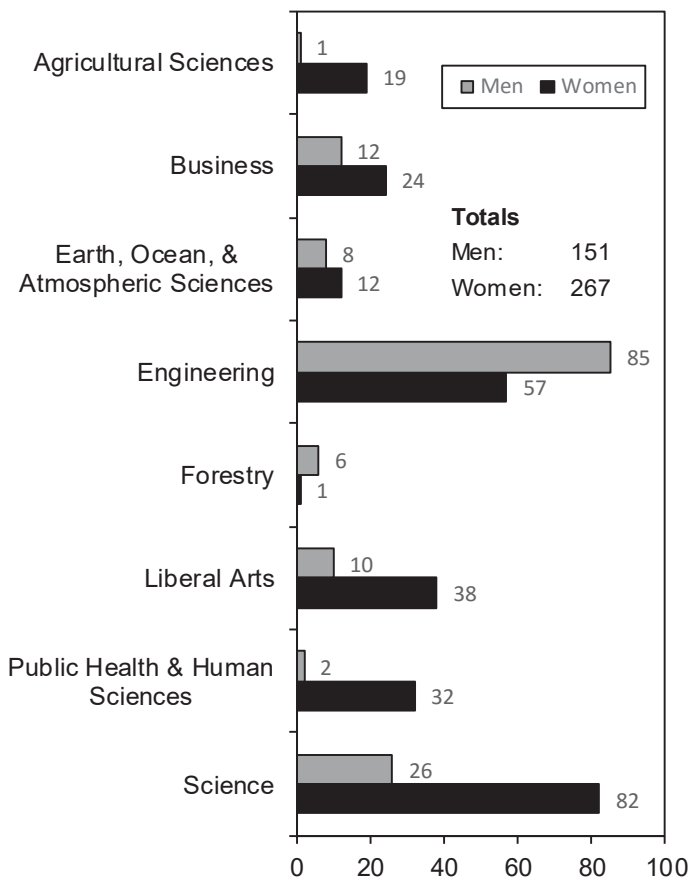

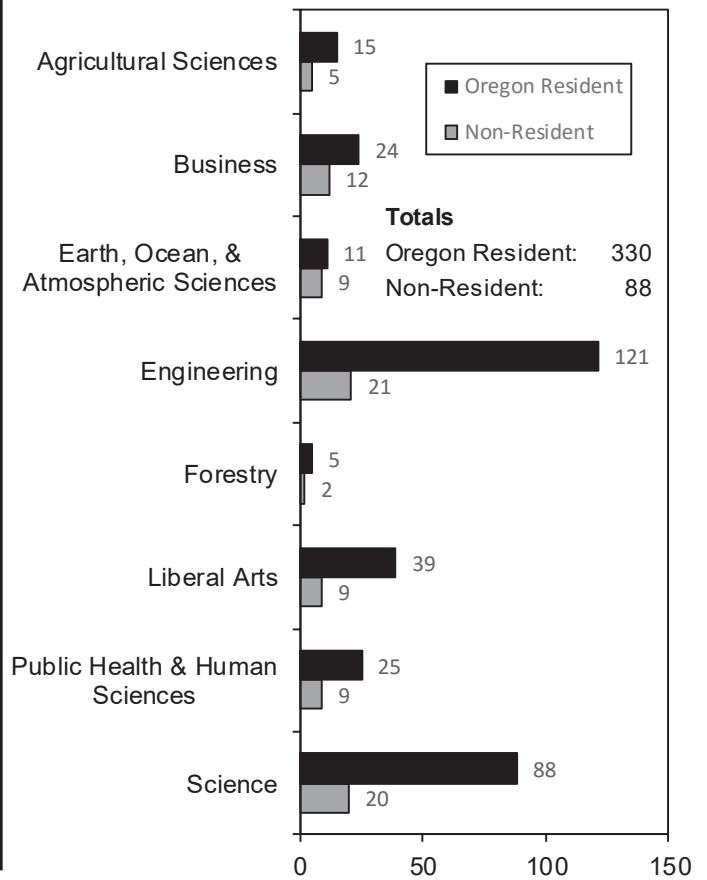

## Highlights

- The Summer Session 2019 total enrollment of 14,408 was 31 more than Summer 2018 - an increase of 0.2%.
- There were more female students than male students in Summer 2019. Female students accounted for 50.3% of total students, while male students accounted for 49.7%.
- 80.5% of students were enrolled on a part-time basis.
- The College of Engineering had the largest unduplicated student enrollment (4,006).
- 45% of the student credit hours were from the College of Liberal Arts (25.5%) and the College of Science (18.4%).
- OSU Extended Campus accounted for 72.7% of enrollments
- Students of color were 24.7% of enrollment.

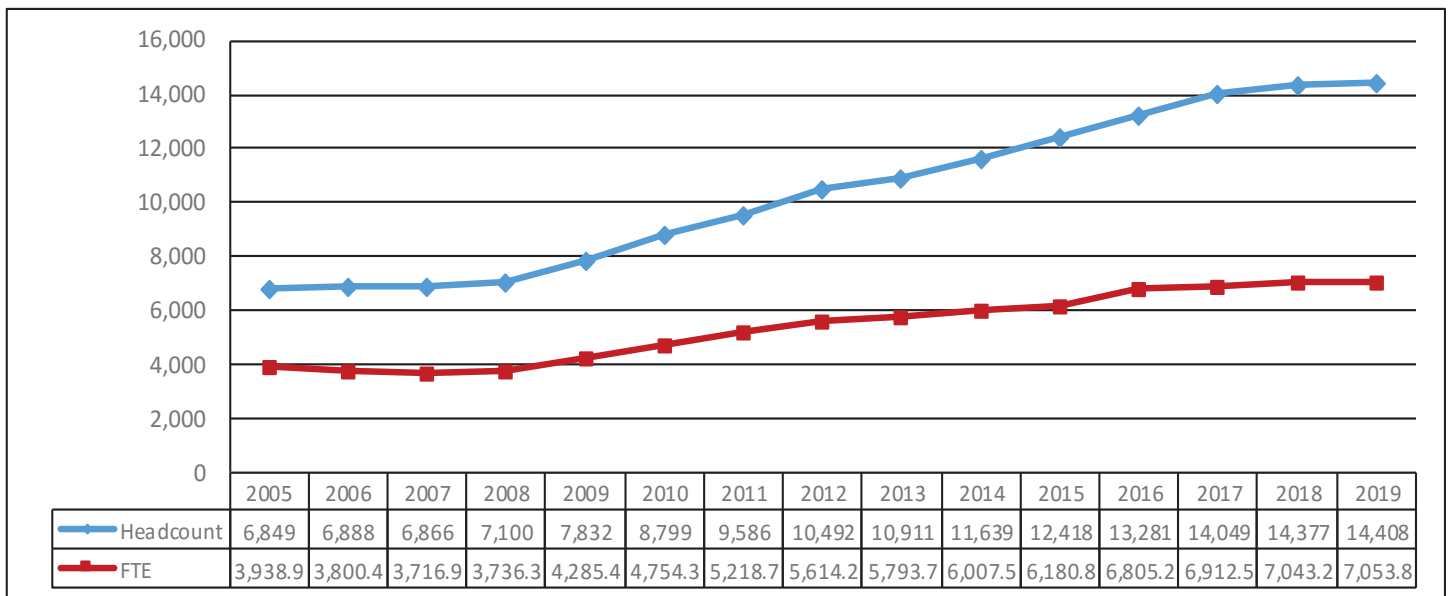
