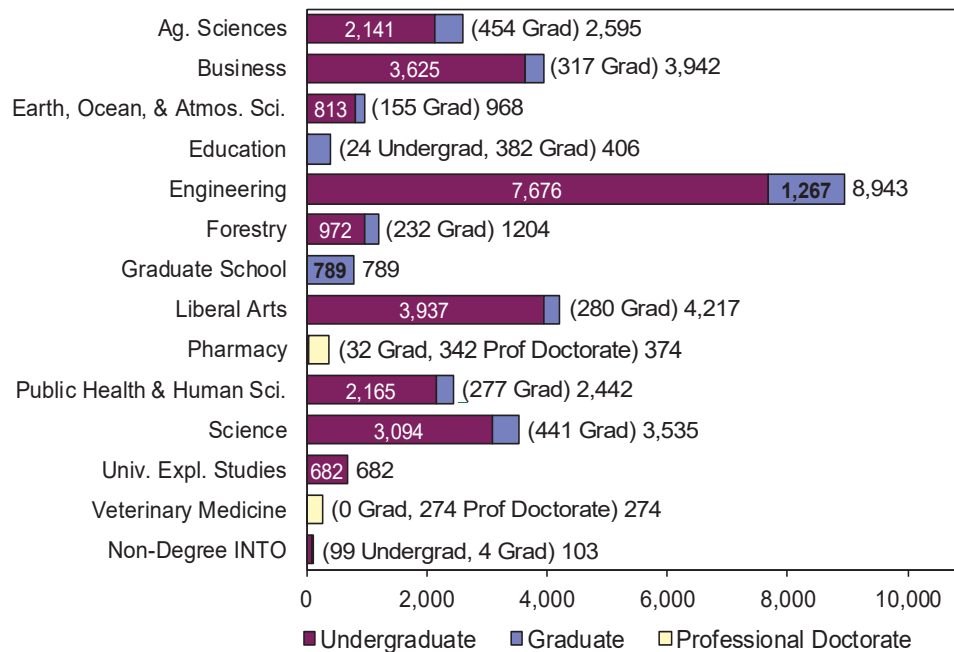

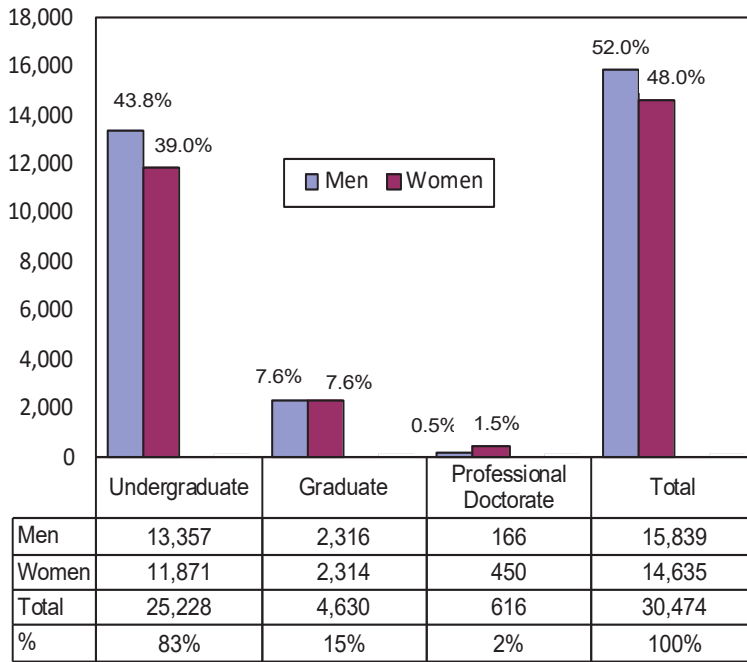

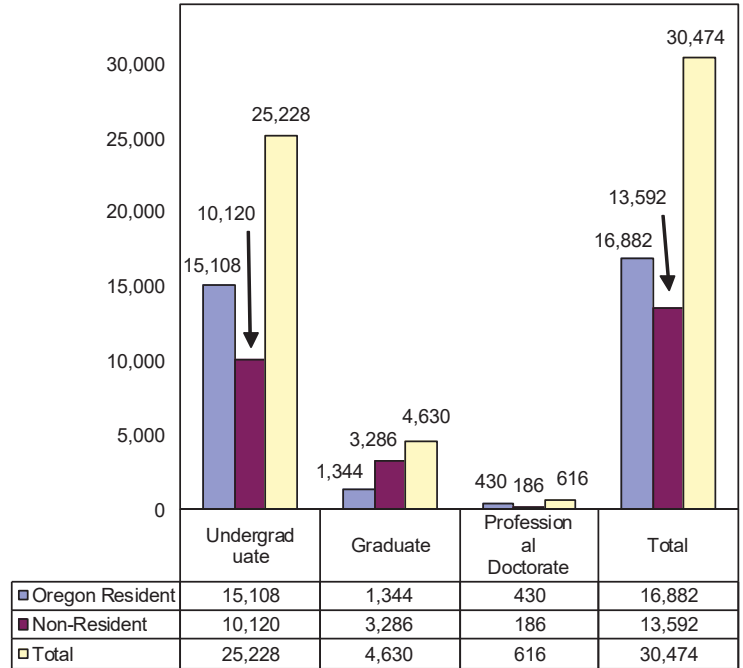

By Residency* and Student Level

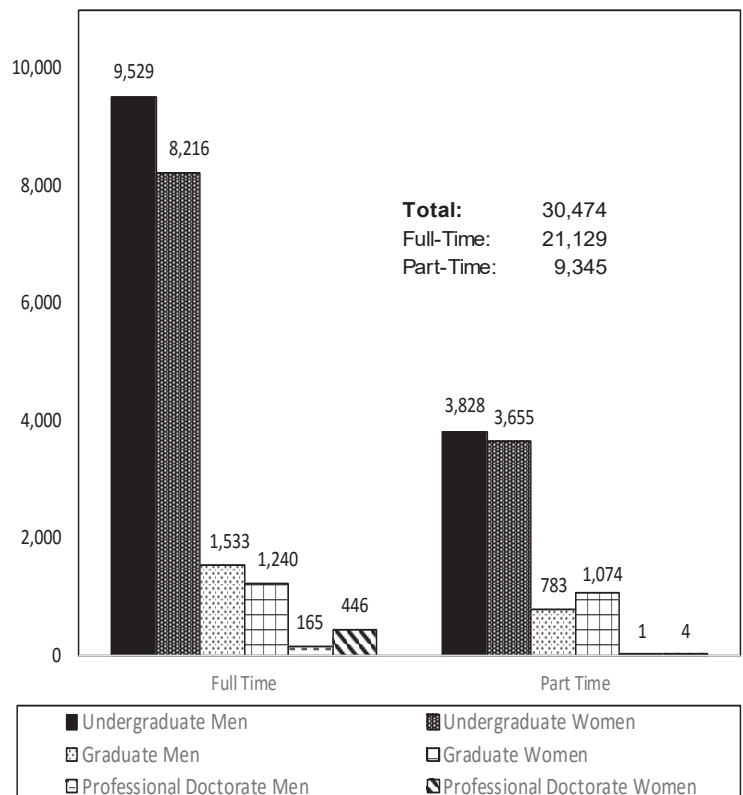

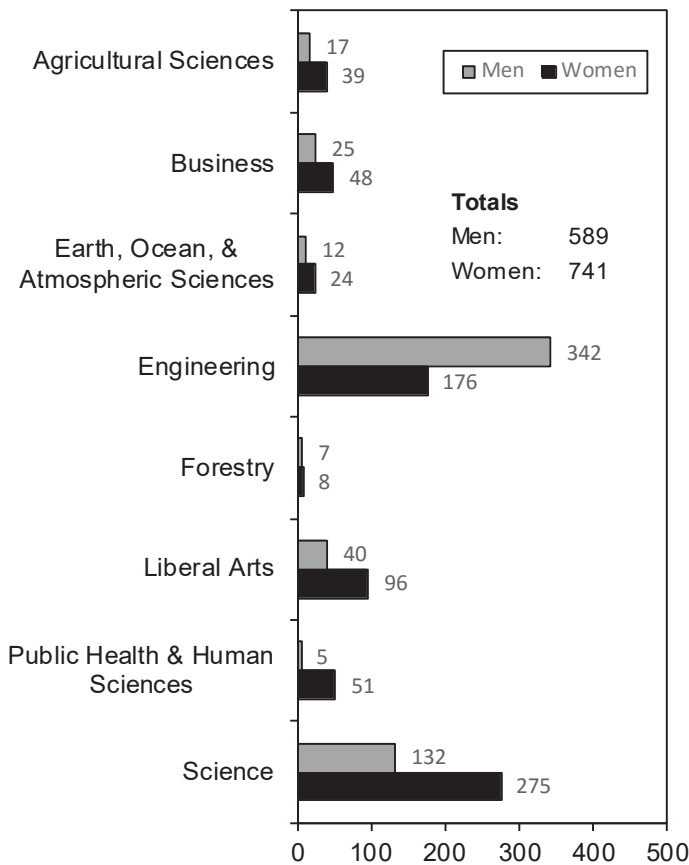

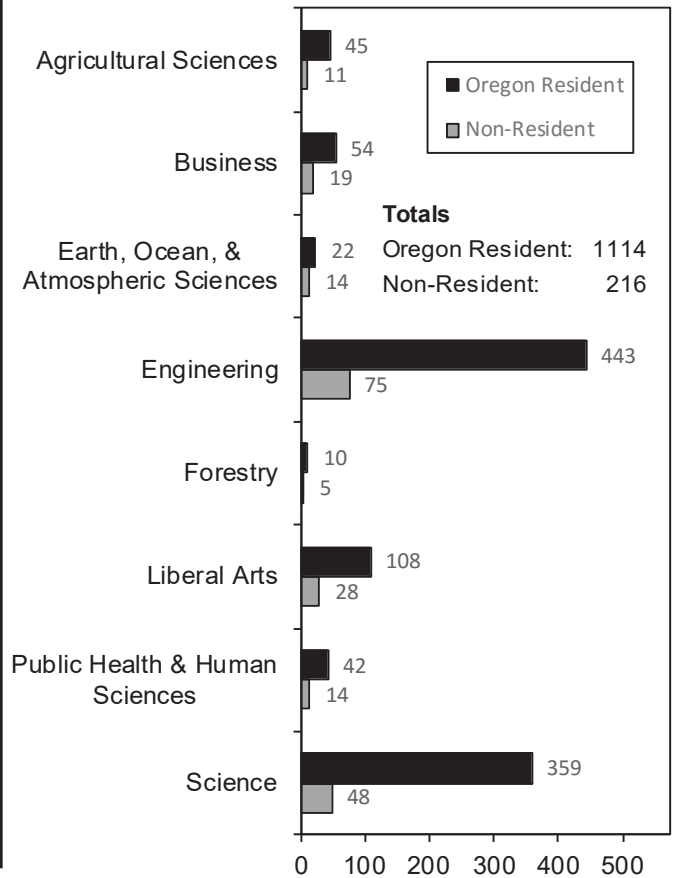

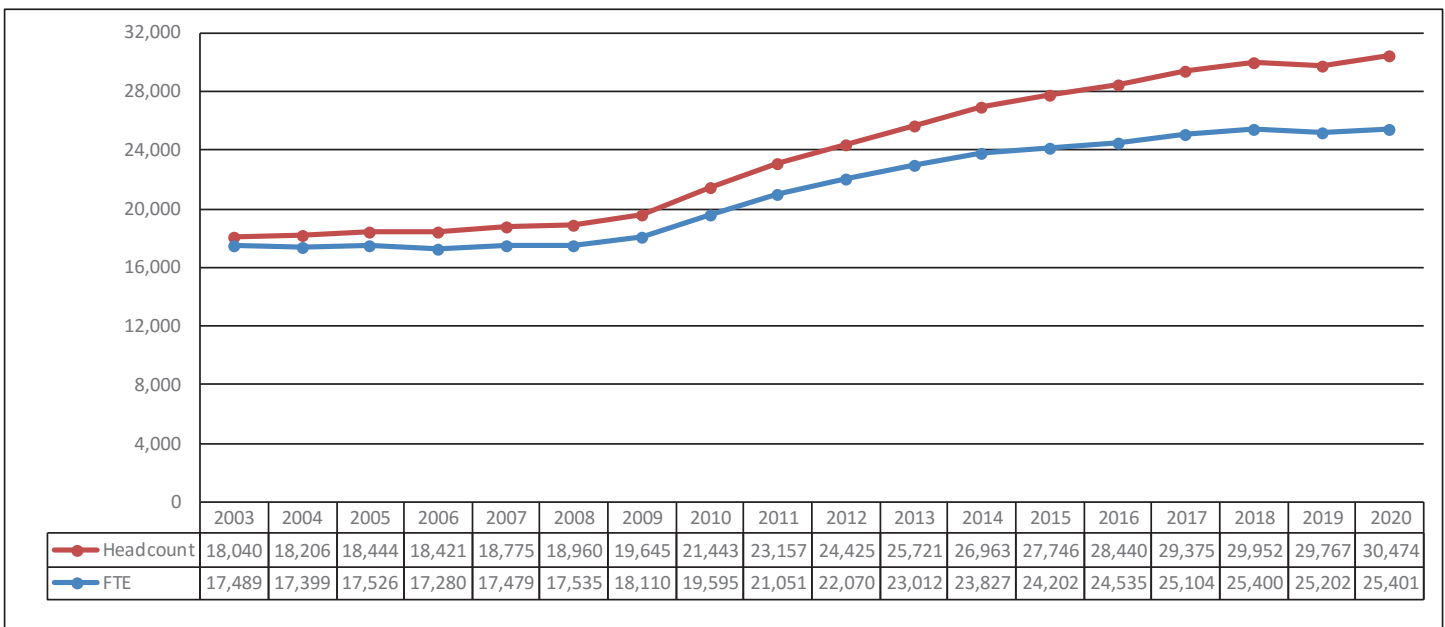
