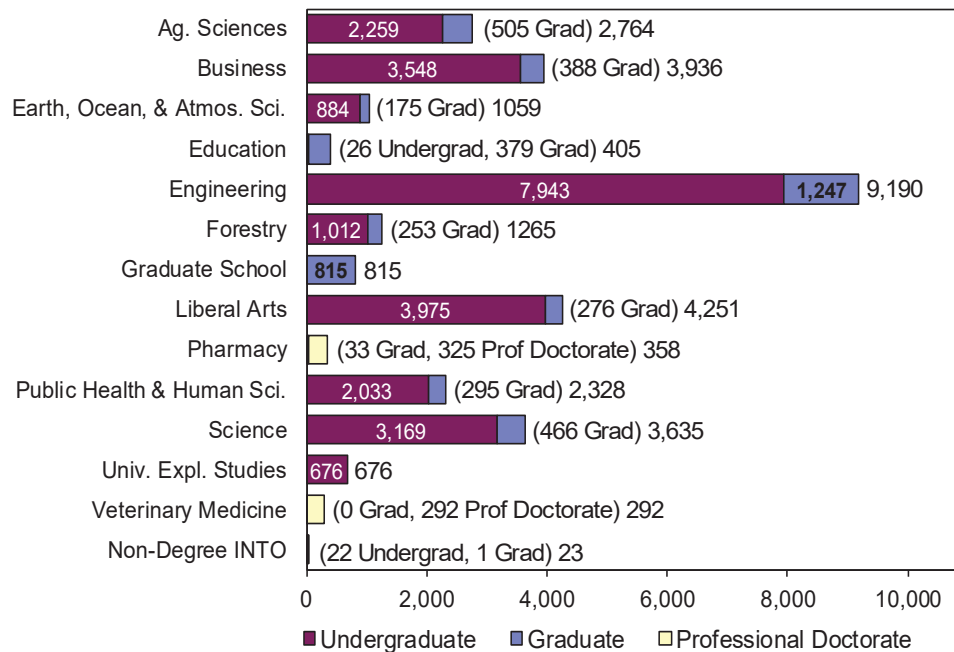

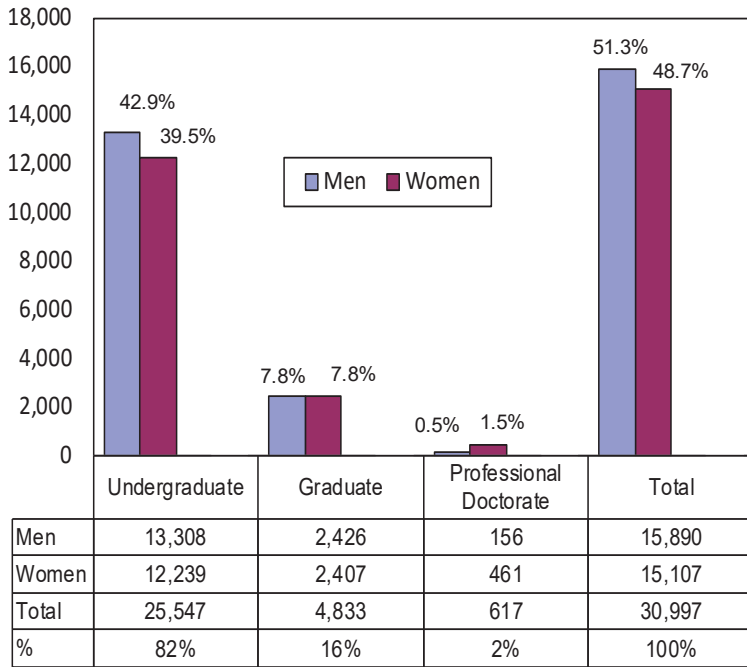

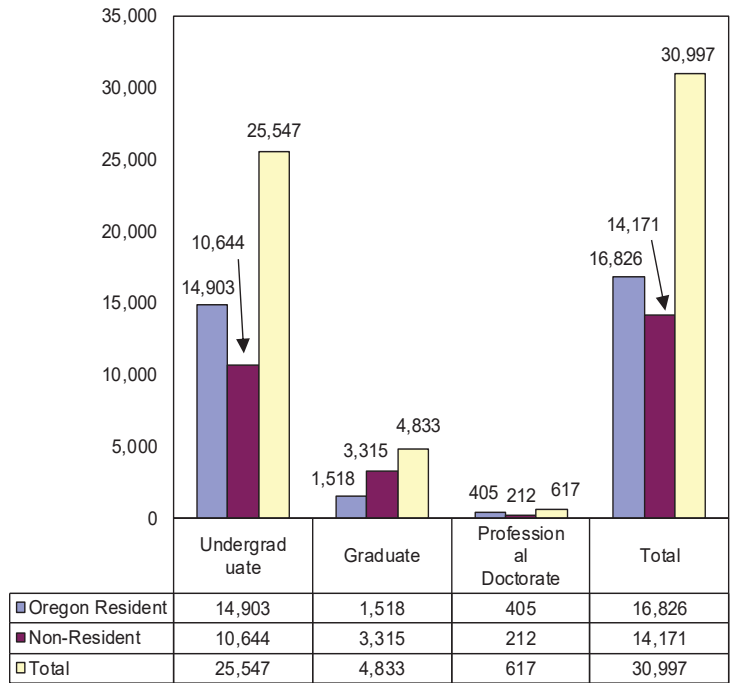

By Residency* and Student Level

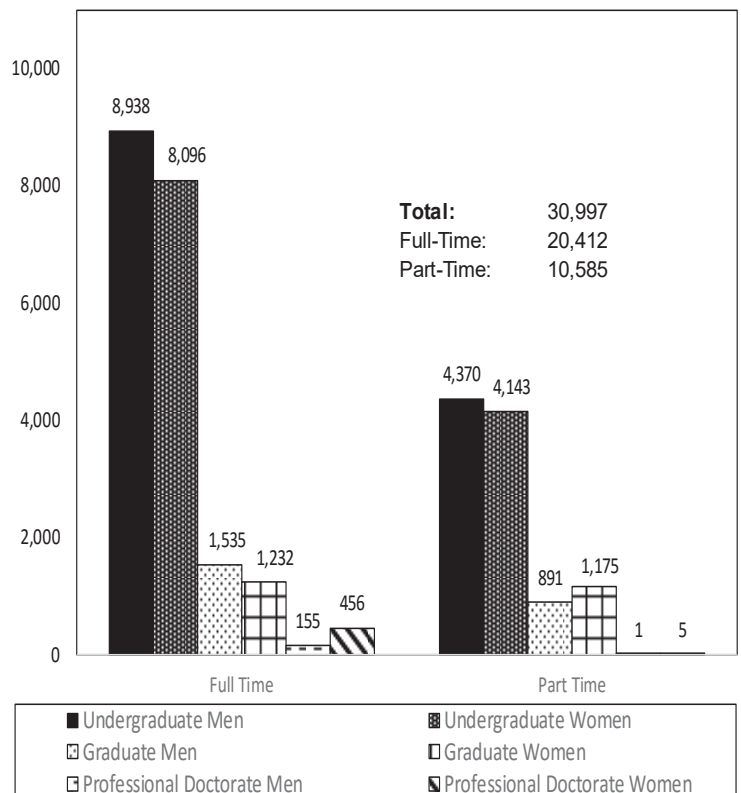

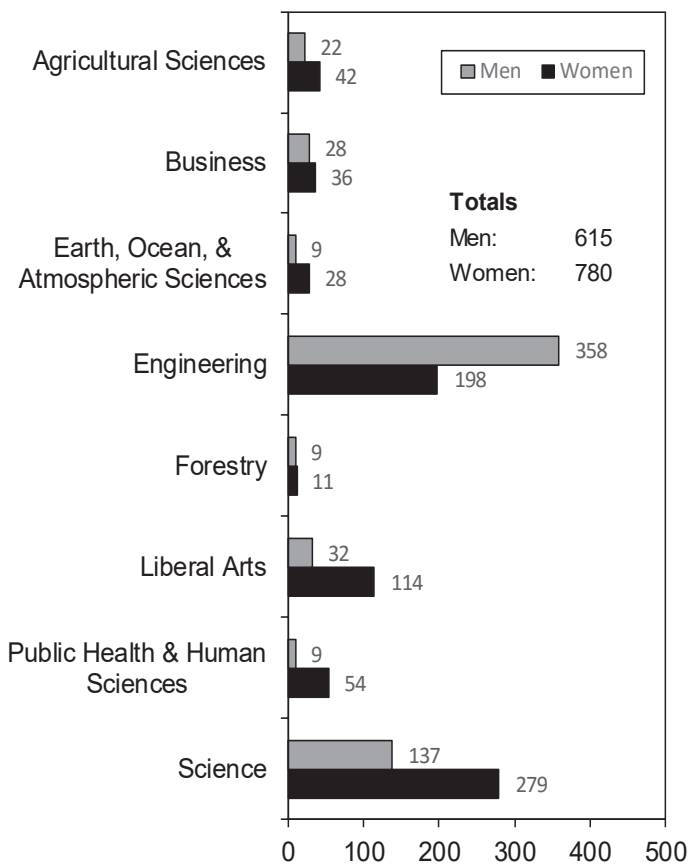

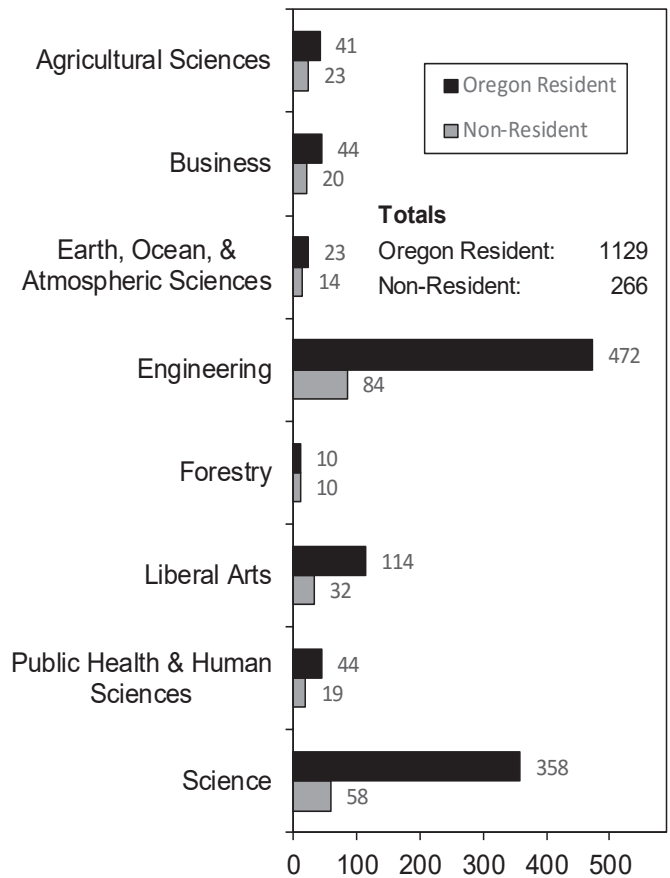

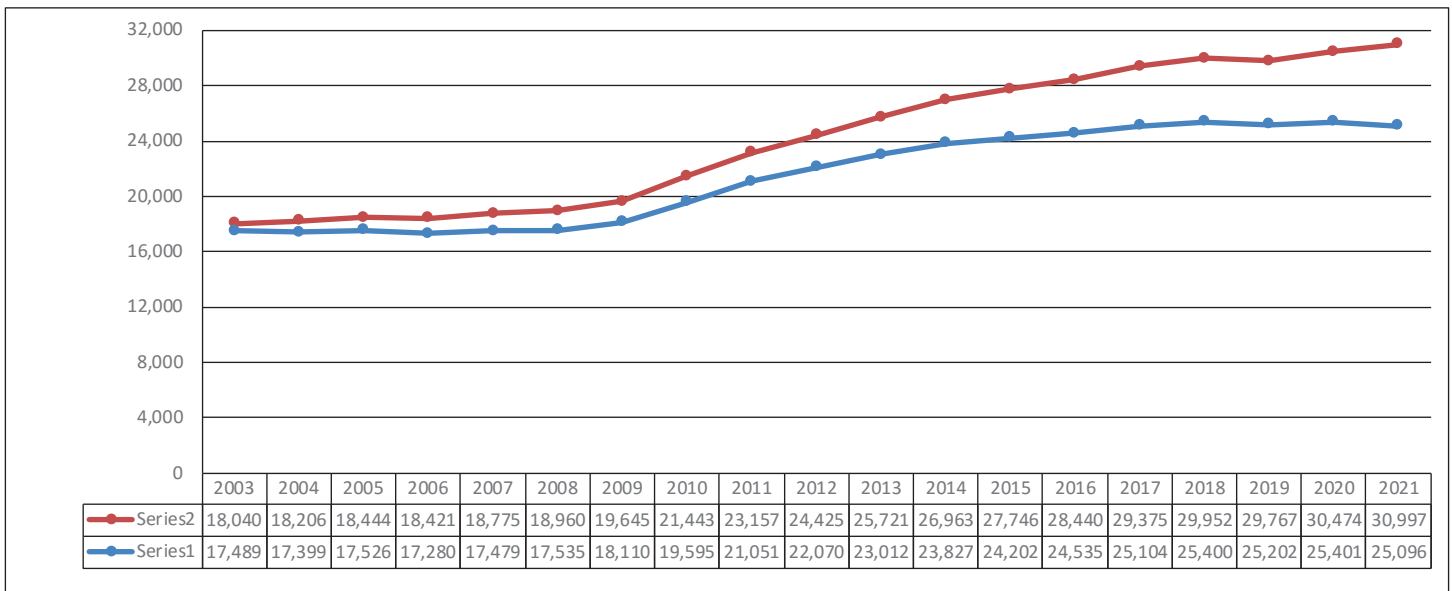

Highlights

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Winter Term courses were offered by remote access.
- Main Campus headcount enrollment grew by 1.7% compared to last Winter, although FTE declined by 1.2% despite a jump in Ecampus FTE, which was unable to offset losses elsewhere.
- OSU Cascades also saw a 1.7% increase in headcount and small decline in FTE. Graduate student enrollment is down 23% compared with last year.
- College of Engineering continues to be the largest college – nearly 30% of headcount
