


Degrees Conferred by Academic Unit and Degree Type








Academic Unit Percent U.S. Minority







Grade Point Average of Graduates






Highlights

- The number of degrees awarded during the 2016-17 academic year was 6,807. In all, OSU has awarded 244,426 degrees through 148 annual commencements.
- Compared to 2015-16, the total number of degrees awarded increased by 6.6%. The number of Bachelor degrees increased by 6.5%; First Professional degrees decreased by -15.9%; Masters degrees increased by 5.2%; and Doctoral degrees increased by 30.0%.
- 6 students received three degrees; and 267 students received two degrees.
- The College of Engineering awarded the largest number of degrees (1762) when compared to the other academic units.
- The average age for Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degree recipients was 25.9, 29.4, 31.9, 28.5, and 34.0, respectively.
- The College of Engineering had the largest percentage of U.S. minority graduates: 23.6%.
- The number of U.S. minority graduates was 1360 or 21% of all graduates in 2016-17. More U.S. minority women (705) than men (655) earned degrees in 2016-17 at OSU.
- 62.5% of the graduates were Oregon residents; 37.5% of the graduates were non-residents.

- The grade point average (GPA) for students receiving Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degrees was 3.27, 3.70, 3.72, 3.36, and 3.78, respectively.
